Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

DAILY ADVENT PEACE PRACTICES

DEC 3 - Today, find an opportunity to embrace one small act of poverty. Make a donation to a charity, provide a meal for someone in need, donate items to a thrift store. And as you carry this out, recall to mind your true treasure which is only found with God.

DEC 4 - Today, reach out to someone you know who suffers in this way. Take a moment and be their Simon of Cyrene. Help them in some small way to carry this cross.

DEC 5 - Today, help someone in a physical way, as much as our bodily strength allows. For some of us, this will mean caring for an infant, attending to the elderly or simply doing the physical labors our job requires. But for others to whom strength is limited, we can still give by hugging someone, making a cup of tea for another, or simply giving a beautiful smile to a stranger

DEC 6 - Today, take a moment to search your own soul and gently acknowledge where your spiritual life is not all it could and should be. Think about and write down how you can become more fully the person God is asking you to be.

DEC 7 - Today, place yourself in the heart of Jesus and realize that these shortcomings of ours are completely forgiven in the love of our God. Leave these burdens with our God instead of constantly carrying them in our souls.

DEC 8 - Take a moment to be aware of all the places that our society still views certain humans as things to be used, rather than people to be loved, respected and protected. Pray for them, pray for our world to change, but above all, pray that we may be the voice of God, crying out for change.

DEC 9 - Pray for a person who has wronged you in some way. Without negating the wrong they have done, pray that God will heal the heart and this person would come to know more fully the great love of Christ. No one is too far gone for the mercy of Jesus.

DEC 10 - Walk the path of Christ by setting a wrong, right. Heal a broken relationship, give without expecting in return, and give love to those who seem they cannot love. And in this small act of righteousness, recall that we bring the kingdom of heaven to earth.

DEC 11 - Listen attentively to the language around you. Reject those words which harm and degrade others or yourself. Make an effort to speak positivity, love and joy into the hearts of those around you.

DEC 12 - Today, upon awakening, say a prayer of thanks. Recognize that you have been given a whole new day to experience life, to grow, eat, laugh, explore, create and discover what it feels like to be fully human, fully alive. Appreciate this amazing gift.

DEC 13 - Living in peace is both an outward and inward experience. Seek to understand that peace is living in a way which embraces respect and tolerance. Live outwardly today in peace by loving each other despite our religious, cultural or political differences. Inwardly, cultivate peace by overcoming and managing your fears and anger. Find some quiet time today to re-charge your soul.

DEC 14 - Comparing and competing with other people is one of the fastest ways to lose your peace and joy. There is a freedom in learning to be happy with who you are and what you have without being jealous of someone else's skills, achievements or possessions. Today think about how blessed you really are.

DEC 15 - Today, share your practice of peacemaking with two other people. As more of us participate in this sharing, our practice will expand into a critical mass, reaching many instead of a few.

DEC 16 - Today, come up with at least one creative idea to resolve a conflict, either in your personal life or your family circle or among friends. Intend to create trust and eliminate hidden hostility and suspicion—the two great enemies of peace.

DEC 17 - Make time to meditate for peace—even five minutes. It will strengthen your sense of calmness and inner peace, and you can carry this feeling with you throughout the busy activities of the day.

DEC 18 - Before you leave the house today, play an uplifting tune you enjoy and have a quick dance. It will wake up your body and align you with your joyful, lighthearted inner spirit.

DEC 19 - If your life is overfilled, today may be a good day to start setting some limits. Stop doing the least important things, the things that honestly don't matter. Set limits on how many times you check inboxes, Instagram, Twitter etc. per day. Use that time to find peace through prayer and presence to the most important things.

DEC 20 - Today, pray this prayer for inner peace, allowing God to take the wheel. "Lord, put your peace in my heart, I'm worried and anxious. My mind races and obsesses. I can't help thinking about my problems. Calm me Lord. Slow me down, put your peace in my heart. No matter what problem I have, Lord, you are bigger and more powerful than it is. I place myself in your hands. Amen."

DEC 21 - Resist the urge to spend your morning buried in your phone screen. Look up at the world around you and protect your sense of inner peace from unraveling due to feelings of comparison and the fear of missing out.

DEC 22 - What you feed your spirit on a daily basis determines the success of one's spiritual journey. If you are reading and listening to things that are not encouraging your soul, try exchanging those for books or podcasts or music that will bring your soul peace.

DEC 23 - Today, make the purpose for speaking be to create happiness in the listener. Have this intention on your mind: Today every word I utter will be chosen consciously. I will refrain from complaints, condemnation, and criticism.

DEC 24 - Choose to see the wonders in the world this day. Wonder brings peace to your life because you are always prepared to see what is good in others. Take a photo today of something you see that causes wonder!

MONARCH NEWS

In a galaxy far, far away more than 500 St. Edward learners and parents enjoyed a star-filled night of creativity, learning and astronomy at the annual Fall Family STREAM Night. A cornerstone of The Parish School curriculum, STREAM (Science – Technology – Religion – Engineering – Art and Math) is an integrated educational approach that guides student inquiry, dialogue and critical thinking.

This educational philosophy comes to life at the bi-annual STREAM nights where learners and their families can explore and create STREAM projects in each of the classrooms. From creating Alka Seltzer rockets in our Upper School Science Lab, to building star constellations with marshmallows and toothpicks, coding robots with iPads, creating a star magnitude gauge and observing static electricity with magnetic tinsel and a balloon, our learners learned about important scientific concepts through interactive projects.

In addition to the classroom projects, learners were inspired by Mike Senna, a local robotic engineer who has built several life-size movie robots for Star Wars and Wall-E. Learners also got to test their measurement and chemical engineering skills during the Out of This World dessert contest with entries including Galaxy Deathstar Cookies, Alien Life Pops, and End of the World Cake. Although the fog and clouds may have prevented star-gazing with the OC Astronomers, the night sky was still lit up as the learners ran through the field with their handmade light sabers.

TOYS: for children 0 thru 12 years. Please leave an unwrapped new toy in the box marked "Toys" in the toy box in the back of church. The most popular toys are dolls, Barbie's, legos, sport balls, science and art & craft kits. Toys that are not popular are coloring books, puzzles and board games.

GIFT CARDS: for teens 13 thru 17 years. Please put a gift card in the Parish Office TEEN GIFT BOX. Most popular gift cards for teens are Visa/Master Card, Walmart, Target, Forever 21, movie theaters, Starbucks. Denominations of \$25 are preferred. We prefer NOT to receive iTunes gift cards since in previous years they were not very popular.

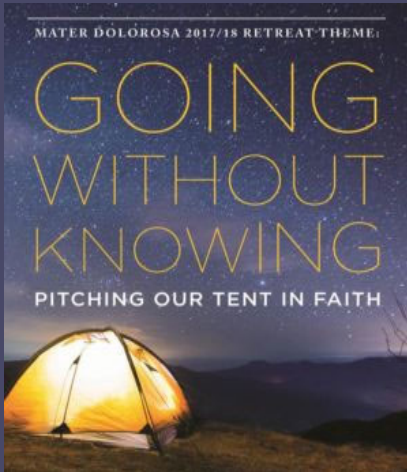

GIVING HOPE & CHANGING LIVES



Imagine your children not being able to go to school because they don't own a pair of shoes. That is exactly the situation for many Filipino children who live on a trash dump on the Philippine island of Cebu.

"Outlet" is our vibrant service-based youth ministry program for all 6th, 7th, and 8th grade youth. Together with parents, students meet twice a month to discuss how they may reach out to the needy among us and perform corporal works of mercy by participating in service projects.

Earlier this year Father Ambrose of the Missionaries of the Poor located in Cebu in the Philippines, came to an Outlet session and spoke to our parish children and their families about the overwhelming needs of the poor in that part of the world.



The poorest of the poor who live on the trash dump ("basura"), collect plastics and aluminum cans to sustain themselves. Their average wage is \$10-\$15 a week which is used to buy rice. Shoes are not high on their priorities. However, the children must have closed toe shoes in order to attend school. Often 3 or 4 children share one pair of shoes retrieved from the trash, so they can attend school at least one day a week.

Additionally, the adults need foot protection as they rummage through the trash for recyclables. Foot wounds and infections are a daily hazard and can easily result in the loss of a limb or even death.

Hearing the stories of the poor, the Outlet families rose to the occasion and spearheaded a parish wide, "Good Soles, No Holes" shoe drive. Through the generosity of our parishioners, 1600 pairs were collected and sent to the Cebu mission.

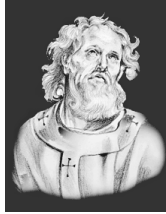


The smiles in these photos tell the story of how the generosity of the St. Edward parishioners are affecting lives of these impoverished children. For the first time in their lives they were able to pick out a "new" pair of shoes.
