Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharistic Adoration

On the first and third Monday of each month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration in San Felipe the 1st Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

No mucho tiempo después de llegar a esta parroquia de San Eduardo era evidente que la mayoría de los feligreses consideran a esta parroquia como una parte de sus vidas muy importante. Para los sacerdotes una parroquia es también como nuestro cónyuge y familia. Este fin de semana, continuamos desarrollando nuestra espiritualidad en lo que es administración, centrándose en nuestra administración de dinero como una ofrenda a Dios y un apoyo a nuestra familia parroquial.

Recibir con gratitud

La Administración comienza con el reconocimiento de que todo lo que somos y todo lo que tenemos es de Dios. No somos los dueños de nada; solo somos los administradores. Como administradores, recibimos todo con gratitud y trabajamos diligentemente para cultivarlo y luego regresar una parte a Dios.

Dar Proporcionalmente

Desde la época de Abraham, el pueblo de Dios ha sido llamado a devolver un diezmo, o el 10%, a Dios. El diezmo no es igual como dar donaciones caritativas en general; es el dinero que le damos de nuevo a Dios a través de nuestra parroquia. Jesús mismo habló sobre el diezmo y, en lugar de revocarlo, el Nuevo Testamento nos invita a ir más allá del diezmo. En otras palabras, el diezmo es el punto de partida para dar, no es el fin! Dios pide a cada uno de nosotros para dar vuelta en la medida que hemos recibido ya sea un centavo o un millón de dólares. El diezmo es una expresión importante de nuestra fe y confianza en Dios.

Dar los Primeros Frutos (no sobras)

Muchos de nosotros no tenemos 10% sobrante al final del mes. De hecho, a algunos no nos sobra nada. Sin embargo, Dios nos pide que le demos a Él nuestros "primeros frutos", no nuestras sobras. "Honra al Señor con todos tus bienes y con las primicias de todos tus frutos; Entonces tus graneros se llenarán con abundancia, y tus lagares rebosarán de vino nuevo "(Proverbios 3: 9-10). En su lista de prioridades, ¿Qué lugar ocupa su ofrenda a Dios los domingos? Son los primeros frutos o las sobras?

Preparación y presentación de su regalo a Dios

Cuando damos un regalo a alguien que queremos, ponemos todo nuestro pensamiento y esfuerzo en él. Incluso la forma en que lo envolvemos puede ser una expresión de nuestro amor. Inclusive escribimos nuestro nombre en él, porque nos sentimos orgullosos del regalo que estamos dando. Nuestra ofrenda a Dios los domingos es similar. Ofrecemos un regalo razonable a cabo (preparados antes de llegar a la misa), y se envuelve en un sobre con nuestro nombre en ella (o a través de donaciones electrónicas).

Por milenios, las familias han estado poniendo sus primeros frutos en una canasta y llevarlos con orgullo y alegría al templo como ofrenda a Dios. ¿Qué don sacrificial estás comprometido con regresar a Dios en el día de hoy ofertorio?

Hacer un Compromiso

Como recordamos abundantes bendiciones de Dios y recibimos con gratitud, te estoy pidiendo que completar una tarjeta de compromiso ofertorio que refleja los primeros frutos que voy a volver a Dios como su oferta Domingo. Me doy cuenta de que el diezmo puede requerir un gran salto de fe para algunos. Por favor dar el salto; Dios simplemente no se deja ganar en generosidad.

Stewardship of Treasure



Not long after coming to St. Edward it became clear to me that most parishioners consider this parish to be a really important part of their lives. For priests a parish is also our spouse and family. This weekend, we continue developing our spirituality of stewardship by focusing on our stewardship of money as an offering to God and a support to our parish family.

Receiving with Gratitude

Stewardship begins with recognizing that everything we are and have belongs to God. We are not owners; we are stewards. As stewards, we *receive* everything with gratitude and work diligently to *cultivate* it and then *return* a portion to God.

Proportional Giving

From the time of Abraham, God's people have been called to give back a tithe, or 10%, to God. Tithing is not a reference to charitable giving in general; it is money that we give back to God through our parish. Jesus Himself spoke about tithing and, instead of revoking it, the New Testament invites us to go beyond tithing. In other words, tithing is the starting point to giving, not the end! God asks each of us to give back in the measure we have received be it a mite or a million dollars. Tithing is an important expression of our faith and trust in God.

Giving First Fruits (not Leftovers)

Not many of us have 10% left over at the end of the month. In fact, some have nothing left over. However, God asks us to give back to Him from our "first fruits," not our leftovers. "Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the *first fruits* of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine." (Proverbs 3:9-10) Where does our Sunday offering to God rank on our list of spending priorities? First fruits or leftovers?

Preparing and Presenting your Gift to God

When we give a gift to someone we love, we put a lot of thought into it. Even the way we wrap a gift can be an expression our love. And, proud of the gift we're giving, we write our name on it. Our Sunday offering to God is similar. We offer a well thought-out gift (prepared before we come to Mass), and wrap it in an envelope with our name on it (or through electronic giving).

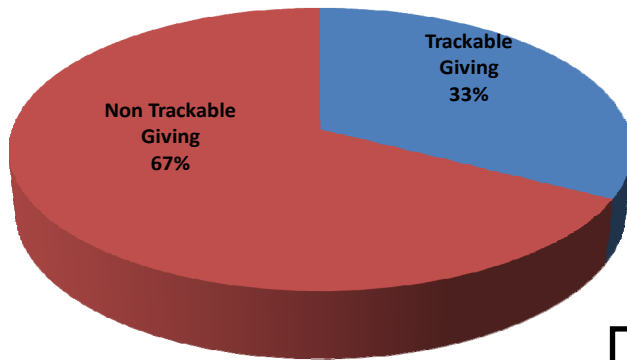
For millennia, families have been placing their first fruits in a basket and bringing them proudly and joyfully to the temple as an offering to God. What sacrificial gift are you committed to returning to God at the offertory today?

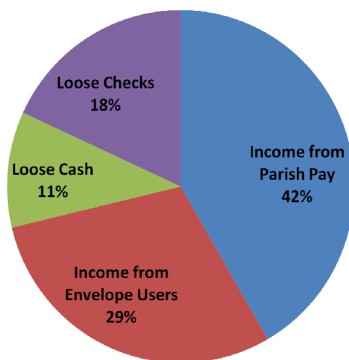
