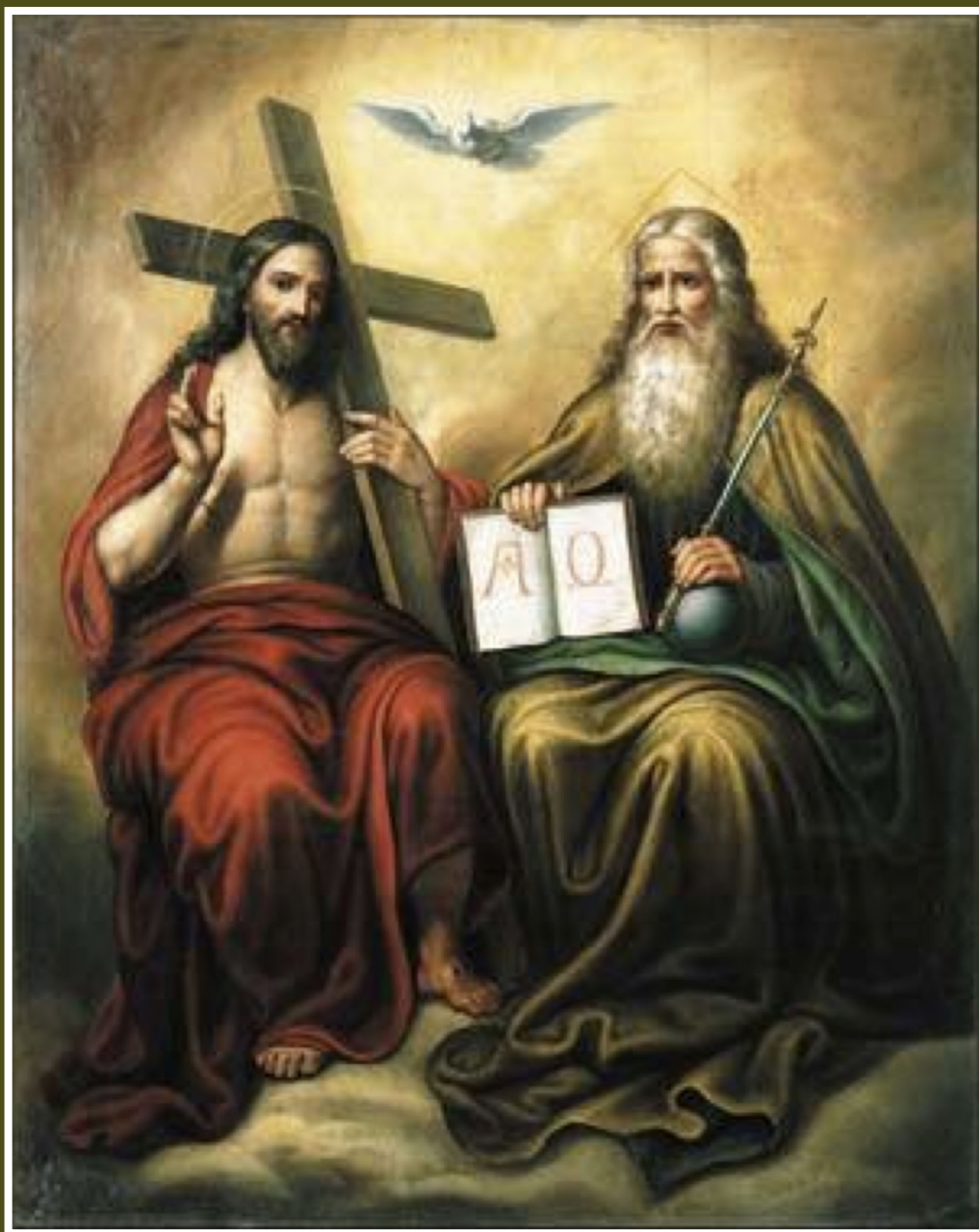

Infant Baptisms are celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month following catechesis for parents and godparents. Parents of infants should contact the Faith Formation office (949) 496-6011 to enroll.

Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

Pastoral Center and Narthex Project Update

The Project Committee (consisting of parishioners, Father Philip, architects, and parish staff) and chaired by long-time parishioner, John Markel, continues with work on the new Pastoral Center and Narthex. This past week we also met with representatives of the Diocese to review design for the Narthex improvements.

As we move forward, architectural designs will be formulated and shared with everyone at a parish community meeting to be held in September 2019. Please watch for announcements in the bulletin, the Beacon, and on the parish website.

We appreciate your continued redemption of pledges to support these efforts—each month we move closer to the 75% cash in bank (about \$12 million) required by the Diocese to begin construction. Based upon your continued support, we are on schedule for a groundbreaking in June 2020 with construction completed by the summer of 2021. To date, we have \$10.3 million in pledges which will be added to \$4 million from Church savings. Through your continued pledge redemptions that average about \$200,000 each month, we have approximately \$9.1 million total in the bank on our way to the 75% Diocesan requirement and our groundbreaking next June.

To that end, if you have not yet made a sacrificial pledge, now is the time to consider joining in these efforts. Please contact the parish business office at (949) 429-2874 for information about pledging to the project.

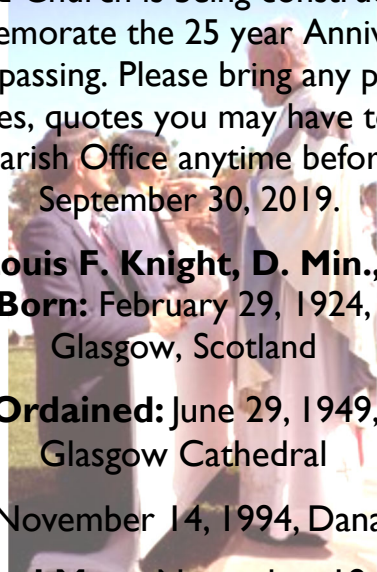

Trinity and Community

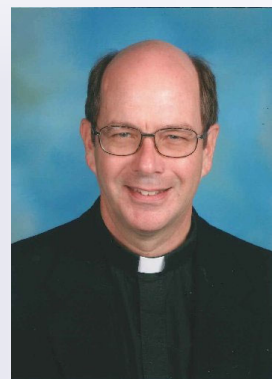
This weekend the Church worships and honors the Blessed Trinity, the Three Persons in One God. These Three Persons are distinct, one from the other, and yet they are equal and perfectly One God. This mystery of Three Persons in One God has been studied, discussed and explained since the earliest days of the Church. It is beyond our complete understanding, but we know it is true from Jesus' own reference to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Mt. 28:19)

We human beings are created in the image and likeness of God. This means that we are also something of a mystery. It also means that we are called to form a community: distinct persons who are united as one. We are called to form a community because God is a Community.

In practical terms, this brings to mind two important questions. Do I respect the unique individuality of each person? And do I strive to cultivate the unity of all persons? The main virtue that helps us accomplish these things is the virtue of charity. No wonder the Scriptures tell us "God is Love" (1 Jn. 4:8)! This week let's give extra effort to the practice of charity in all our thoughts, words, and actions. In this manner we will become a living act of praise of the Blessed Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen!

Este fin de semana, la Iglesia adora y honra a la Santísima Trinidad, a las Tres Personas en un solo Dios. Estas Tres Personas son distintas, una de la otra, y sin embargo son iguales y perfectamente un solo Dios. Este misterio de Tres personas en un Dios ha sido estudiado, discutido y explicado desde los primeros días de la Iglesia. Está más allá de nuestra comprensión humana, pero sabemos que es verdad por la propia referencia de Jesús al Padre, al Hijo y al Espíritu Santo. (Mt. 28:19)

En términos prácticos, esto trae a la mente dos preguntas importantes que nos debemos hacer. ¿Respeto la individualidad de cada persona? ¿Me esfuerzo por cultivar la unidad de todas las personas? La principal virtud que nos ayuda a lograr estas cosas es la virtud de la caridad. ¡No es de extrañar que las Escrituras nos digan "Dios es amor" (1 Juan 4:8)! Esta semana, esforcémonos a la práctica de la caridad en todos nuestros pensamientos, palabras y acciones. De esta manera nos convertiremos en un acto de alabanza a la Santísima Trinidad: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. ¡Amén!

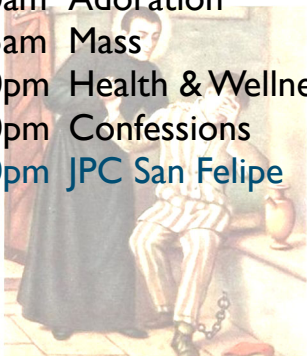

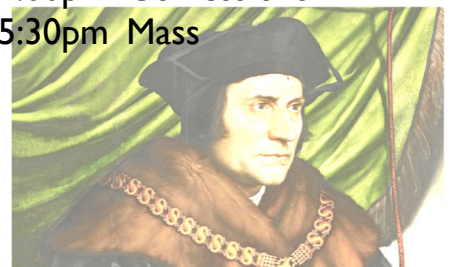

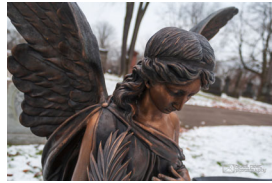

Missionary Bishop Visit



This weekend, we welcome Bishop Chad Zielinski from the mission Diocese of Fairbanks in Alaska.

Bishop Zielinski faces the challenging task of shepherding the largest geographic diocese in the United States with only seventeen priests, compounded by Alaska's

vast distances and the isolation of the Catholic communities from access to roads.

Amongst the poorest dioceses in the nation, only 8 of its 46 parishes and missions are capable of financial self-support. Bishop Zielinski will share the site story of the Catholics living in the missions of Northern Alaska at each of our Masses, and invite our prayerful consideration to helping him provide for the proper pastoral and sacramental care of our far northern sisters and brothers.

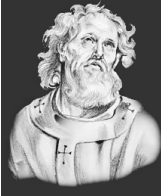
