

## Full of Grace

When the Angel Gabriel spoke to the Virgin Mary at the Annunciation, the angel greeted her with the words, "Hail, full of grace." When we repeat these words in one of our best-known Catholic prayers, we add her name: "Hail, Mary, full of grace." The fact that the angel did not use her name does not diminish the greeting given to Mary; it simply shows us the key to her identity: she was filled with the life and love of God.

The Easter Season gives special emphasis to the reality of our Baptism, since it is the cornerstone of our identity as Christians. In Baptism the life and love of God enters us in a particularly strong way, making us "full of grace." As Christians, we have a special relationship with God and also with everyone who shares the life of grace. This includes a special relationship with the Virgin Mary.

Are we still full of grace? Well, we are not perfect. We do our best to cultivate the life of grace God gives us. As we do so, it is only right that we look to Mary, who is the Mother of all Christians. The month of May is especially dedicated to her, so this is a good time to remind ourselves that the Mother of Christ is our mother as well. She looks out for us and prays to her Son with us and for us. Pray an extra "Hail Mary" every now and then during this month as a powerful expression of faith that our holy Mother prays for us "now and at the hour of our death."

## Llena de Gracia

Cuando el ángel Gabriel le habló a la Virgen María en la Anunciación, el ángel la saludó con las palabras: "Salve, llena eres de gracia". Cuando repetimos estas palabras en una de las oraciones católicas más conocidas, añadimos su nombre: "Ave, María, llena eres de gracia". El hecho de que el ángel no usara su nombre no disminuye el saludo dado a María; simplemente nos muestra la clave de su identidad: estaba llena de la vida y del amor de Dios.

El Tiempo de Pascua da un énfasis especial a la realidad de nuestro Bautismo, ya que es la piedra angular de nuestra identidad como cristianos. En el Bautismo, la vida y el amor de Dios entra fuertemente a nosotros de una manera particular, haciéndonos "Ilenos de gracia". Como cristianos, tenemos una relación especial con Dios y también con todos los que comparten la vida de la gracia. Esto incluye una relación especial con la Virgen María.

¿Estamos todavía llenos de gracia? Bueno, no somos perfectos. Hacemos nuestro mejor esfuerzo para cultivar la vida de gracia que Dios nos da. Al hacerlo, es justo que miremos a María, ella es la Madre de todos los cristianos. El mes de mayo está especialmente dedicado a ella, por lo que este es un buen momento para recordarnos que la Madre de Cristo es nuestra madre también. Ella nos cuida y ora a su Hijo con nosotros y por nosotros. Recen un "Avemaría" adicional de vez en cuando durante este mes, como una poderosa expresión de fe de que nuestra santa Madre reza por nosotros "ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte".




