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Bring a Friend

It is gratifying to see a gradual, but noticeable, increase of people coming to Mass each weekend. Without a doubt, some are people who were away during the worst days of the pandemic, but are now feeling safe to gather again. Others are visitors; almost every week when I'm greeting people after Mass, visitors will introduce themselves to me. And perhaps there are even people who have simply decided to come to Mass after a long time away. Whatever a person's stated reason for coming to Mass may be, underlying all other reasons is the call of the Lord. I pray that the Lord may call more and more people to our church, and I pray that those who hear his call will follow it.

All of this brings me to a very effective means that the Lord uses to call people to worship him: your invitation! Yes, you can be the voice of God in someone's life just by inviting them to come to Mass. Readily we recommend movies that we like to our friends; we encourage them to go to shows we have enjoyed, and to visit websites that we find interesting; we invite them to parties and other gatherings. But when was the last time you invited someone to come with you to the greatest prayer, arguably the greatest event, on earth?

I bring this up today as Holy Week approaches. You will find the schedule of Holy Week liturgies in this bulletin and on the parish website. These liturgies are especially rich in meaning, and contain Scripture texts, prayers, ritual actions, and music that are particularly moving. Why not make it a special point this year to bring at least one guest to at least one of our Holy Week liturgies? A practical note: it's best to invite someone now, at least a week in advance, before their schedule fills up with other things.

I look forward to seeing you, and your guests, at St. Edward the Confessor or San Felipe de Jesús, soon.

Traer un Amigo

Es gratificante ver un aumento gradual, pero notable, de personas que asisten a Misa cada fin de semana. Sin duda, algunas son personas que estuvieron fuera durante los peores días de la pandemia pero que ahora se sienten seguras para reunirse nuevamente. Otros son visitantes; Casi todas las semanas, cuando saludo a la gente después de Misa, los visitantes se presentan conmigo. Y quizás haya incluso personas que simplemente han decidido venir a Misa después de un largo tiempo fuera. Cualquiera que sea la razón para venir a Misa, subyacente a todas las demás razones siempre está el llamado del Señor. Oro para que el Señor pueda llamar a más y más personas a nuestra iglesia, y oro para que aquellos que escuchen su llamado lo sigan.

Todo esto me lleva a un medio muy efectivo que el Señor usa para llamar a la gente a adorarlo: ¡su invitación! Sí, usted puede ser la voz de Dios en la vida de alguien con solo invitarlo a venir a Misa. Fácilmente recomendamos a nuestros amigos películas que nos gustan; los alentamos a asistir a espectáculos que hemos disfrutado y visitar sitios web que nos parecen interesantes; los invitamos a fiestas y otras reuniones. Pero ¿cuándo fue la última vez que invitó a alguien a acompañarlo a la celebración más grande, posiblemente el evento más grande, de la tierra?

Les hablo de esto hoy que se acerca la Semana Santa. Encontrará el horario de las liturgias de Semana Santa en este boletín y en el sitio web de la parroquia. Estas liturgias son especialmente ricas en significado y contienen textos de las Escrituras, oraciones, rituales y música que son particularmente conmovedoras. ¿Por qué no hacer un esfuerzo este año para traer al menos un invitado por lo menos a una de nuestras liturgias de Semana Santa? Una nota práctica: es mejor invitar a alguien ahora, con una semana de anticipación, antes de que su agenda se llene con otras cosas.

Espero verlos pronto a usted y a sus invitados en San Eduardo el Confesor o San Felipe de Jesús.
