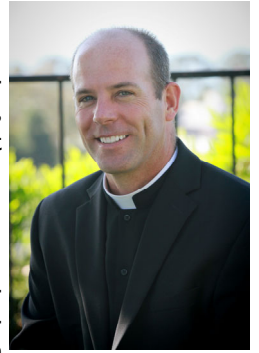
Eucharistic Adoration

Renovation Update

A few weeks ago, I wrote about the possibility of refurbishing the interior of the church. Our former Pastor, Fr. Steve Sallot, began this process a few years ago with the consultation of the parish pastoral council, finance council and a committee of staff members and parishioners. I continued this planning process last year and am pleased to announce that we're moving forward.



What is going to be done?

Although the church is 20 years old and is used by thousands of people every week, it has held up extremely well due to the vigilance of our maintenance staff and the financial support of parishioners. However, things simply don't last forever. We need to continue our good stewardship by replacing what is worn out and prepare the church for the next generation of believers.

The renovation of the church will consist of new carpet, tile, pews, speakers, and a fresh coat of paint. A new altar, ambo (podium), chairs for the priest and deacon, processional cross, candle stands, monstrance, and tabernacle will also be designed and purchased.

The four blocks of straight pews in the main body of the church will be replaced by radial, or rounded, pews. The pews will complement the shape of the church and will slightly increase our seating capacity. The theater seating in the balcony will also be replaced with radial pews.

The Stations of the Cross were brought over from our old church, now known as Knight Hall. Although they are beautiful, they are small for the size of our church. Nonetheless, we are looking into the possibility of refinishing and reframing them.

The new tabernacle will remain in same location as the current tabernacle. No changes are being made to the structure and shape of the sanctuary, or the interior of the church. It is beautiful the way it is!

The baptismal font has been problematic from the day it was built. Despite endless maintenance, it leaks and tiles fall off every week. Therefore, a new baptismal font will be designed and constructed.

Liturgical consultants have noted the unfortunate absence of any commissioned art in our church. Therefore, one of the most stunning elements of the renovation will be a commissioned piece of art called a retablo, also known as a reredos. A retablo is an ornamented wall or screen that rises behind the altar of a church, forming a background for it. In addition to enhancing the beauty of the church, it will also attract and direct our eyes, minds, and hearts to Jesus Christ uniquely present in the Eucharist (altar), the Word of God (ambo) and the priest (presider's chair).

The retablo will be made from different types of glass so as to allow the beauty of creation to shine through, while focusing our attention on the Creator. Incorporated into the retablo will be a cross on which will hang our existing corpus of Christ. Yet another benefit of the retablo is that it will provide a beautiful and quieter place for people to pray before the Blessed Sacrament.

Mary's Chapel is currently a mixture of devotional items. The main devotional image in the renovated chapel will be a traditional image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patroness of our diocese and of all the Americas. More details will be decided later.

What is it going to cost and who's paying for it?

Virtually nothing has been replaced in the church since it was dedicated 20 years ago; therefore, we have a lot to do. The parish finance council has approved a budget of three million dollars. Due to the generosity of parishioners and the good stewardship of Fr. Steve Sallot, the parish staff, and the finance council, the parish has saved all the money needed for the project. Therefore, there will not be a parish capital campaign or even a second collection. At the same time, there will be several naming opportunities for those who would like to be a patron of a particular aspect of the renovations.

All of us who come to St. Edward the Confessor Church are benefiting from the sacrifices and contributions of the founding members of the parish and parishioners over the last twenty years. Likewise, we will soon enjoy a beautifully renovated church because of what people have given in the past. It is up to all of us to continue this generosity so that we will be able to provide for the current and future needs of parishioners.

When it is going to be done?

The renovation will begin after Christmas and is scheduled to be completed in March. During this time, the church will be closed; Sunday Masses will held in Knight Hall and a tent will be used for overflow crowds.

At this point, the only concrete decision that has been made and approved is the purchase of the pews. Each and every aspect of the renovation must first be approved by the bishop, Diocesan Construction Board and the Diocesan Design and Renovation Committee. I will continue to communicate any and all developments with you through the parish website and the bulletin.

Lo ultimo en la Remodelación de la Iglesia

Hace algunas semanas, escribí sobre la posibilidad de la remodelación del interior de la iglesia. Nuestro antiguo párroco, el Padre Steve Sallot, inició este proceso hace algunos años con la consulta del consejo, un comité de miembros del personal y algunos feligreses. Seguí este proceso de planificación del año pasado y me complace anunciar que estamos avanzando.

¿Qué se va a hacer?

La iglesia tiene aproximadamente 20 años y es visitada por miles de personas cada semana, se ha mantenido muy bien debido al mantenimiento de nuestro personal y el apoyo financiero de los feligreses. Sin embargo, las cosas simplemente no duran para siempre. Tenemos que continuar nuestra buena administración mediante la sustitución de lo que está desgastado y preparar la Iglesia para la próxima generación de creyentes.

La renovación de la iglesia consistirá en nuevas alfombras, baldosas, bancos, altavoces, y una capa de pintura fresca. Un nuevo altar, ambón (podio), sillas para el sacerdote y el diácono, cruz procesional, soportes de la vela, custodia, y el tabernáculo también será rediseñado y remplazado.

Los cuatro bloques de bancas principales en la iglesia serán reemplazados por bancas redondeadas o en forma de curva,. Las bancas van a complementar la forma de la iglesia y se incrementarán ligeramente nuestra capacidad de asientos. Los asientos del balcón también se reemplazará con bancas radiales.

Las Estaciones del Vía Crucis fueron traídas de nuestra antigua iglesia, hoy conocida como Knight Hall. A pesar de que son hermosas, son pequeñas para el tamaño de nuestra iglesia. No obstante, estamos estudiando la posibilidad de renovación del acabado y la reformulación de ellas.

El nuevo tabernáculo se mantendrá en la misma ubicación que el tabernáculo actual. No se realizaron cambios en la estructura o en la forma del santuario, tampoco en el interior de la iglesia. Ya es hermosa en la manera que esta ahora!

La pila bautismal nos ha dado problemas desde el primer día. A pesar de mantenimiento que se le ha dado el agua se filtra y los azulejos alrededor de ella se caen constantemente. Por lo tanto, una nueva pila bautismal será diseñada y construida.

Consejeros litúrgicos han señalado la ausencia de arte en nuestra iglesia. Por lo tanto, uno de los elementos más impresionantes de la renovación será una pieza de arte llamada retablo. Un retablo es una pared ornamentada o pantalla que se levanta detrás del altar, formando como una pared o fondo. Además de resaltar la belleza de la iglesia, también queremos atraer y dirigir nuestros ojos, mentes y corazones a Jesucristo que de forma real y verdadera se encuentra en la Eucaristía (altar), la Palabra de Dios (ambón) y el sacerdote (la silla del celebrante).

El retablo se realizará de diferentes tipos de vidrio con el fin de permitir que la belleza de la creación brille a través de el, mientras que se centra nuestra atención en el Creador. Incorporado en el retablo habrá una cruz en donde colgará el Cristo que actualmente tenemos. Sin embargo, otro beneficio del retablo será el lugar hermoso y tranquilo que tendremos para que la gente pueda orar ante el Santísimo Sacramento.

La Capilla de María es actualmente una mezcla de artículos devocionales. La principal imagen devocional en la capilla será una imagen tradicional de la Virgen de Guadalupe, patrona de nuestra diócesis y de las Américas. Mas detalles de esto más adelante.

¿Cuánto va a costar todo esto y quién va a pagar por ello?

Prácticamente nada se ha remplazado de la iglesia desde que se construyo hace 20 años; Por lo tanto, tenemos mucho que hacer. El consejo de asuntos económicos de la parroquia ha aprobado un presupuesto de tres millones de dólares. Gracias a la generosidad de los feligreses y la buena administración del P. Steve Sallot, el personal de la parroquia, y el concejal han ahorrado todo el dinero necesario para el proyecto. Por lo tanto, no habrá una campaña de la parroquia o segunda colecta. Al mismo tiempo, habrá varias oportunidades para aquellos que quieran dar su opinión en aspectos particulares de la renovación.

Todos los que vienen a la Iglesia de San Eduardo el Confesor se han beneficiando de los sacrificios y contribuciones de los miembros fundadores de esta parroquia y feligreses durante los últimos veinte años. Del mismo modo, pronto podremos disfrutar de una iglesia, magníficamente restaurada, por lo que la gente ha dado en el pasado. Consiste en todos nosotros el continuar aportando con generosidad para poder satisfacer las necesidades actuales y futuras de todos los feligreses.

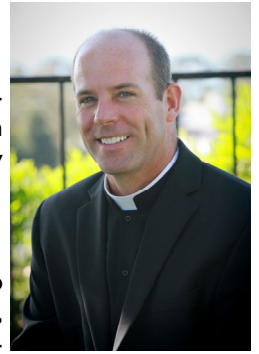
¿Cuándo se va a hacer esto?

La renovación se iniciará después de la Navidad y está programada para ser terminada en marzo. Durante este tiempo, la iglesia estará cerrada; Las Misas dominicales se celebrará en el salón Knight Hall y se utilizaran lonas para celebrar otras Misas.

Hasta ahora la única decisión concreta que ha sido elaborada y aprobada es la compra de las bancas. Todas y todos los aspectos de la renovación deben ser aprobados por el Obispo Diocesano, Junta Constructora y el Diseño Diocesano y Comité de Renovación. Seguiré en comunicación con ustedes y los desarrollos de este proyecto través de la página web y el boletín.

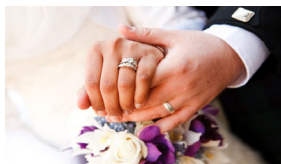
