Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

Advent: 25 Days of Prayer and Compassion



As we celebrate the last Sunday of Ordinary Time this weekend, Jesus speaks to us about His coming again in glory and the final judgment. The standard or criteria that Jesus gives for entering eternal life or eternal punishment is how we have cared for Him in this life. In today's Gospel, both the righteous who are granted eternal life *and* those who go off to eternal punishment claim to have never have seen Christ. They asked: "When did we see you hungry or naked or imprisoned?" Jesus reminds us that what we do for the least among us we do for Him.

Fr. Henry Nouwen wrote:

"When we claim our own poverty and connect our poverty with the poverty of our brothers and sisters, we become the **Church of the poor**, which is the Church of Jesus. Solidarity is essential for the Church of the poor. Both pain and joy must be shared. As one body we will experience deeply one another's agonies as well as one another's ecstasies. As Paul says: 'If one part is hurt, all the parts share its pain. And if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy' (1 Corinthians 12:26). Often we might prefer not to be part of the body because it makes us feel the pain of others so intensely. Every time we love others deeply we feel their pain deeply. However, joy is hidden in the pain. When we share the pain we also will share the joy."

As we begin the sacred and joyful season of Advent next Sunday we are invited to join **25 Days of Prayer and Compassion**, a daily journey aimed at helping us see and serve Christ in the least among us. Each day, we will be brought into the presence and light of the least among us through prayer and a small activity. Because Advent is a joyful season and because it is an absolute joy to serve Christ in others, the 25-day journey is designed to be fun.

By our baptism, each of us is a living house of God. During Advent we want to fill our individual, family, and parish house with personal and communal prayer. Together with the Sacraments and daily devotions, the Blue Books are back this year as a way of helping us grow together into a **house of prayer**.

A limited number of **25 Days of Prayer and Compassion** booklets are available in the parish office; however, the entire journey is available at online **HouseofPrayerandPoor.com**. Please post your pictures and comments online as well as we journey in solidarity to see and serve Christ in the least among us.

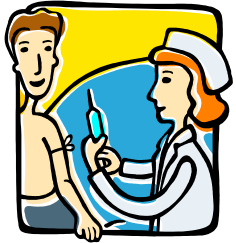

Adviento: 25 Días de Oración y Compasión

Al celebrar el último domingo del Tiempo Ordinario este fin de semana, Jesús nos habla de su segunda venida Gloriosa y el juicio final. La norma o criterio que Jesús da para entrar en la vida eterna o el castigo eterno es cómo hemos cuidado de él en esta vida. En el Evangelio de hoy, tanto los justos que se conceden la vida eterna y los que van fuera de la reivindicación castigo eterno a tener nunca han visto a Cristo. Le preguntaron: "¿Y cuándo te vimos hambriento o desnudo o encarcelado?" Jesús nos recuerda que lo que hacemos por el más insignificante de nuestros hermanos, lo hacemos por Él.



El Padre Henry Nouwen escribió:

"Cuando decimos que nuestra propia pobreza y conectamos nuestra pobreza con la pobreza de nuestros hermanos y hermanas, nos convertimos en la Iglesia de los pobres, que es la Iglesia de Jesús. La solidaridad es esencial para la **Iglesia de los pobres**. Tanto como el dolor y la alegría deben ser compartidos. Como un solo cuerpo experimentamos la profunda agonía de los demás, así como la alegría de los demás. Como dice San Pablo: "De manera que si un miembro padece, todos los miembros se duelen con él, y si un miembro recibe honra todos los miembros con él se gozan." (I Corintios 12:26). A menudo preferimos no ser parte del cuerpo, ya que nos hace sentir el dolor de los demás con intensidad. Cada vez que amamos profundamente a los demás sentimos profundamente su dolor. Sin embargo, la alegría se esconde en el dolor. Cuando compartimos el dolor también vamos a compartir la alegría".

Al comenzar la temporada sagrada y gozosa de Adviento el próximo domingo se nos invita a unirnos a **25 Días de Oración y Compasión**, un viaje diario destinado a ayudar a ver y servir a Cristo en los más pequeños entre nosotros. Cada día, pondremos la presencia y difícil situación de los más pequeños entre nosotros a través de la oración y una actividad pequeña. Debido a que el Adviento es un tiempo de alegría y porque es una alegría absoluta poder servir a Cristo en los demás, el viaje de 25 días está diseñado para ser algo divertido.

Por nuestro bautismo, cada uno de nosotros somos una casa viva de Dios. Durante el Adviento queremos llenar nuestra persona, la familia y la casa parroquial con la oración personal y comunitaria. Junto con los sacramentos y devociones diarias, los Libros Azules están de vuelta este año como una manera de ayudarnos a crecer juntos en una **casa de oración**.

Hay un número limitado de folletos disponibles de **25 días de oración y compasión** en la oficina de la parroquia; sin embargo, todo el recorrido está disponible en línea en la página **HouseofPrayerandPoor.com**. 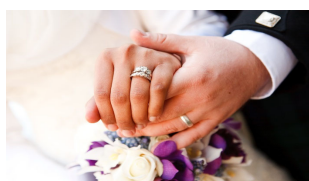

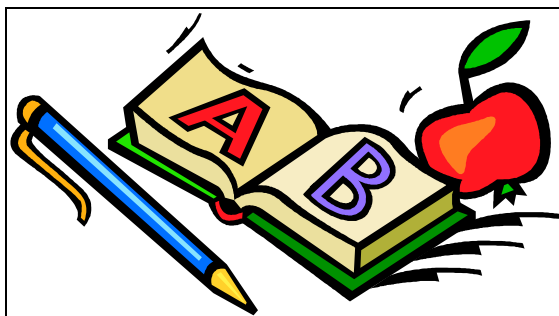
