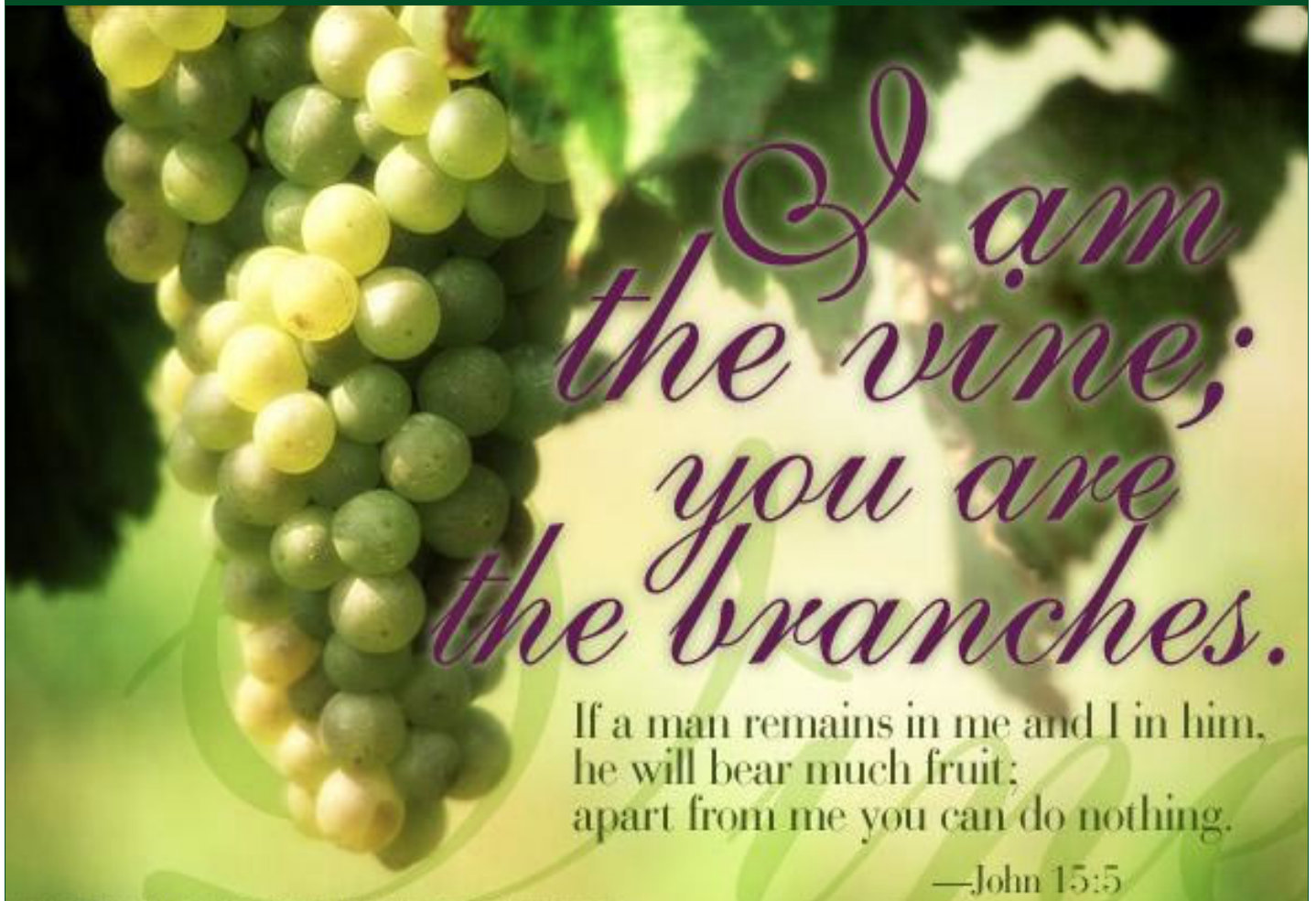

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

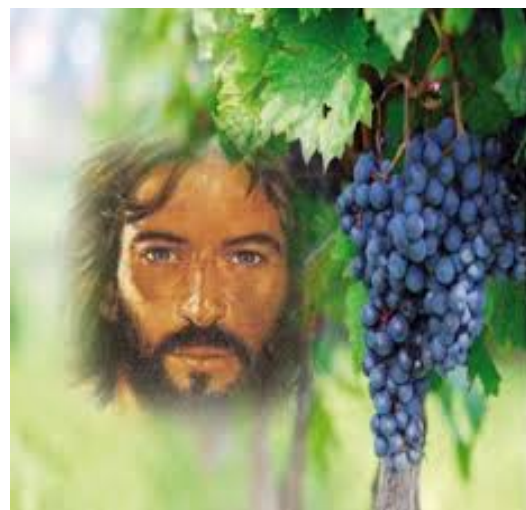

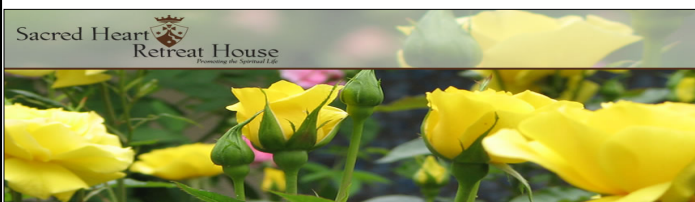

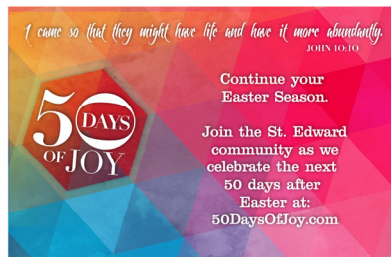

Families of Nazareth Movement

The Families of Nazareth Movement (FNM) began in the early 1980's in Poland where a small community of people found themselves searching for a way leading to spiritual growth and sanctity. It then spread rapidly beyond the borders of Poland and it is now present on all the continents. Its members seek a radical way of entrusting themselves to God through the Blessed Virgin Mother. They follow the example of such spiritual masters as Saint John of the Cross, Saint Therese of Avila, Saint Therese of Lisieux, and Saint Maximilian Kolbe. In the Movement, a special emphasis is placed on the spirituality of Nazareth – following Jesus in his poverty and humility.

In its essence, the charism of the Movement consists of an effort to live in full personal communion with Christ the Savior, described as: *"The act of total abandonment for the service of Christ in His Holy Church."* This communion teaches the love of God and of other human beings in the way Christ loves.

Explanation of Spirituality of the Families of Nazareth Movement

- † Emphasis on Spiritual Life and Formation
- † Charism – By the grace of the Holy Spirit, through Our Blessed Mother, we aren't afraid to present to God our weaknesses and misery. In fact, we benefit from our weaknesses because they help us to more fully experience God's Redemptive Mercy, especially in and through the Eucharist and Confession. Surrendering to God's will through Mary, we entrust ourselves to her so that she will lead us to humility, trust, and total obedience to God. In her arms, we can become Eucharistic People in order to receive and spread His Mercy to others with childlike trust. We recognize that the graces received from spiritual direction and frequent participation in retreats assist us in this.

Ministry Spotlight

The World Apostolate of Fatima **(Our Lady's Blue Army)**

Mary's message at Fatima can be synthesized in these clear, initial words of Christ 'the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel' "(Mk 1:15) Pope John Paul II at Vatican City, 1991

Our times are characterized by a spirit of confusion, dissatisfaction, insecurity and indifference. The multiplying effect of humanity's sins, the contempt for the issues concerning God and the order established by the Creator, and the violence present in human relations, have a devastating effect over the collective spirit of our societies which become sick, weakened, old and agonizing. Many people are conscious of these conditions but feel there is nothing they can do to remedy it.

What can we do? We must face the crisis of our times with the spiritual weapons prescribed by the Holy Virgin of Fatima: **PRAYER, PENANCE, CONVERSION, CONSECRATION TO HER IMMACULATE HEART, ADORATION AND EUCHARIST REPARATION.**



What Happened at Fatima?

Through a series of six apparitions from May 13 through October 13, 1917, the Blessed Virgin Mary invited all mankind to prayer, conversation, consecration and reparation as the sure means of obtaining world peace. Her message was validated on October 13, 1917 by the Miracle of the Sun. More than 70,000 people in a 36-mile radius of Fatima, saw the sun make abrupt movements in the sky and plunge to the earth.

A message of hope: Our Lady of Fatima prophesied the rise of communism, World War II and persecution for the Church, but added that in the end, her Immaculate Heart would triumph and an era of peace would be granted to mankind.

The World Apostolate of Fatima (Our Lady's Blue Army) is a movement, approved by the Holy See, with millions of people throughout the world responding to the requests made by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima, Portugal.

Our Lady's Blue Army at St. Edward the Confessor invites you to join them

on Tuesdays after the 5:30 p.m. Mass (6 to 7pm) and for First Saturday Devotion after the 8:15 a.m. Mass to honor Our Blessed Mother's requests for personal conversion, the daily Rosary for world peace, prayers and sacrifices for sinners who have no one to pray for them, & reparation to the Eucharistic Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

First Saturday Devotion: Mary promised special graces at the hour of death to all who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months: (1) go to Confession and receive Communion, (2) recite five decades of the Rosary and (3) keep her company for 15 minutes by meditating on the Mysteries of the Rosary.
