Three Archangels

On Thursday of this week, September 29, we celebrate a special feast. It is the feast of three archangels who are powerful heavenly friends for all of us: they are Saint Michael, Saint Gabriel, and Saint Raphael.

St. Michael the Archangel is the patron saint of fighting against the devil; the Scriptures attest to his effectiveness in this area. For the same reason, St. Michael is the patron of all battles, of the military, of security officers, and police; for less

obvious reasons he is the patron of bankers, grocers, and mariners.

St. Gabriel is the patron of communication in all its forms; remember that St. Gabriel brought the world the message of the Incarnation when he announced it to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He is patron of those who work in radio, in television, in all telecommunications, and in the postal service. Related to this, he is also patron saint of stamp collectors.

St. Raphael, as is documented well in the book of Tobit, is the patron saint of travelers, of doctors, nurses, and pharmacists; he is patron of the blind, and he is also the patron of happy meetings.

If all these different activities are protected by three archangels, and if we remember that there are millions of angels and lots of other saints besides, we can see how every area of human activity is touched by divine providence. As often as not, God exercises that providence through his angels. They will assist us as we struggle against evil, and seek to communicate only what is good, and travel through this world to the next. Let's be mindful of their help until we join all the angels and saints in the eternal praise of God.

San Rafael, como bien se documenta en el libro de Tobías, es el patrón de los viajeros, de los médicos, enfermeros y farmacéuticos; es patrón de los ciegos, y también es patrón de los felices encuentros.

Si todas estas cosas están protegidas por tres arcángeles, y si recordamos que hay millones de ángeles y muchos otros santos, además, podemos ver cómo cada área de la actividad humana es tocada por la providencia divina. A menudo, Dios ejerce esa providencia a través de sus ángeles. Ellos nos ayudarán mientras luchamos contra el mal, y buscamos comunicar solo lo que es bueno, y viajar de este mundo al siguiente. 

Study the Scriptures!



EDGEMiddle School Ministry



The Diocese of Navrongo-Bolgatanga is located in the northern part of Ghana in West Africa, with Catholics forming 15% of the population of 1.5 million. Fr. Rudy will be speaking about his diocese's efforts to provide meaningful basic healthcare for retired clergy and religious who have served in northern Ghana for the past several decades.

These retired missionaries and local evangelizers who ministered in the diocese were never on a salary, nor on a pension plan. The diocese seeks to provide some retirement housing near a hospital where healthcare can be more easily accessed.




SERVE AT THE ALTAR
