Sacrament of Matrimony

FAREWELL TO DEACON RON AND DEBI TIBERI

Dear Parish Family;

When God calls you to a different field it's exciting. It's also sad because you have to let go of the familiar, comfortable and predictable parts of your life. You have to say good-bye to family and friends.

We've been called to a new area to live God's mission and my ministry in another area of His vineyard. Many of you know that we had closed our business on July 31st. When that happened the opportunity to move to Illinois and be near our son and granddaughter opened and it became clear to my wife, Debi, and myself that we were being called to move. We are moving to the Belleville, Illinois area, just East of St. Louis, Missouri. The physical and logistical particulars of moving aside, we knew this was going to be a process. The move itself has been physically taxing, but as of now, all our belongings are in a storage unit in Illinois. Debi went back in mid-September to begin her job search. I'm leaving this coming week and as soon as our home in San Clemente sells we will buy a home back there. It's no longer possible for us to have one person in Illinois and one in California. We are a unit, a team, and we need to be together as we start our new life and God's work. I've already written to the Bishop of Belleville to request permission to obtain faculties and perform my Deacon duties back there.



So now we have to say good-bye to this wonderful parish community. During our many years here I've been privileged to participate in the liturgical celebrations of this parish, to provide you my insights when I've preached, to baptize children, witness weddings and participate in the funeral rites of our faith family here. Each is a precious part of my ministry, and I thank you for allowing me to be present in the important moments in your lives.

Your love and support have been so wonderful to both Debi and myself. You've seen us through tough times, health crisis's and discouraging moments in our lives. Your prayers care and concern for each of us has sustained us and thank you can never fully express our gratitude.

St. Edward is an amazing parish, vital, full of love for God and the Sacraments. It's been our joy to be part of this community and to know you. Each of you is special to us and we ask for your prayers as we move to our new home. We want to assure you that you will always remain in our heart and our prayers.

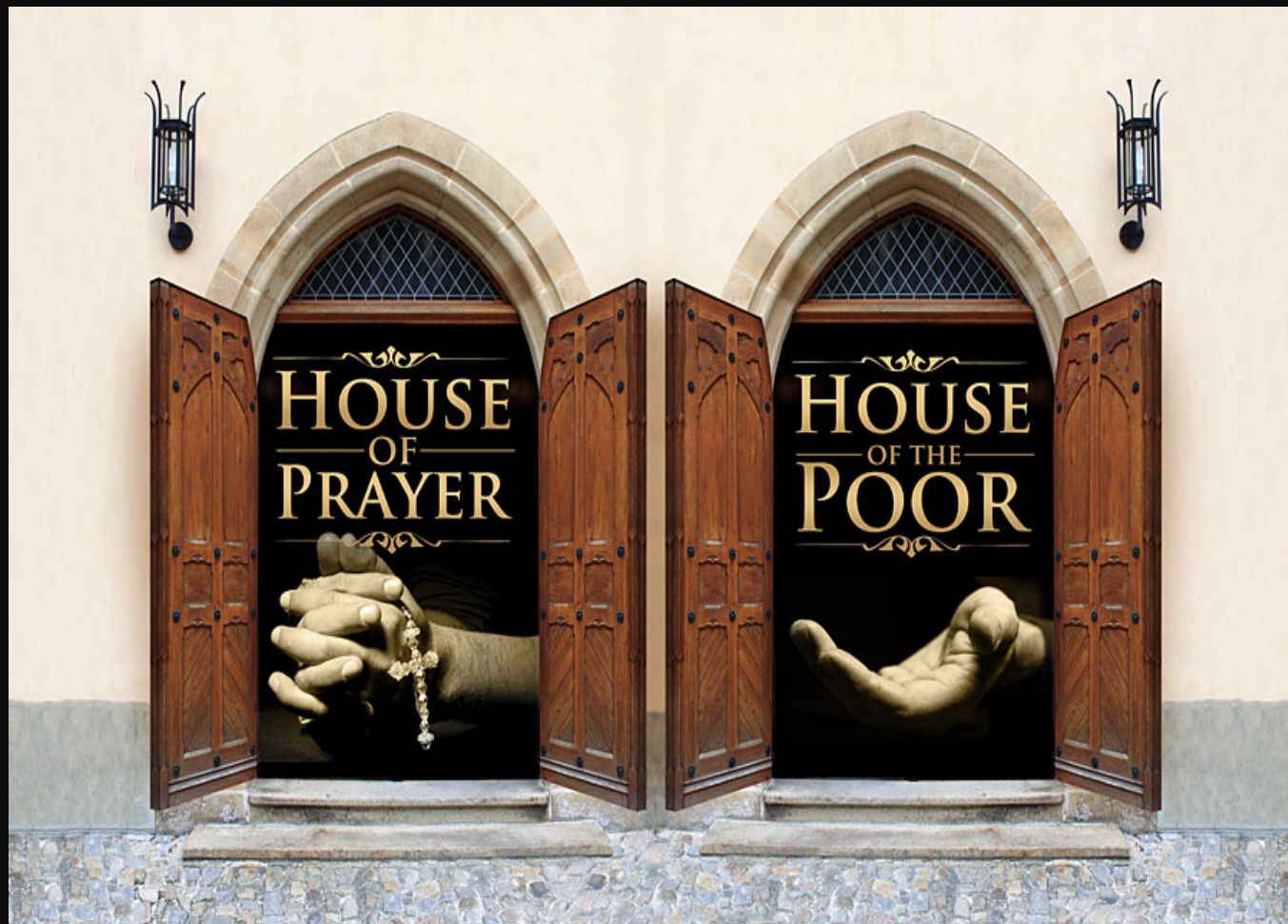

St. Edward the Confessor Parish Is A House of Prayer & A House of the Poor

On one of the many occasions when Jesus entered the temple, he said “my house shall be a house of prayer” (Is 56:7; Lk 19:45). Many, if not most of us consider our parish an extension of our own home. Some of our most treasured memories take place here: baptisms, First Communions, Sacrament of Confirmation, weddings, anointing of the sick and funerals. The church is also a place of life-long learning for children and adults.

Our parish home is a meeting-place of friends and a refuge where we are sure to find Christ, our friend.

Prayer is a beautiful dialogue between God and us in which we listen and speak to each other.

Through our baptism we truly become a living house of prayer as St. Paul says “Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit” (I Cor 6:19). Over the course of this year we will be renovating our house of prayer with a fortified foundation of communal and personal prayer. Two thousand years ago one of the disciples said to Jesus, “Lord, teach us to pray” (Lk 11:1). Through our liturgies, homilies, retreats, website and bulletin resources, bible studies and faith formation programs, our Lord will teach us how to pray and to discover in prayer a place of “light, happiness, and peace” (Roman Canon).

However, God’s house, our house of prayer, must extend beyond the walls of the church. Shortly after his election, Pope Francis told journalists “Ah, how I would like a church that is poor, and for the poor.”

Throughout the year, each of us will be given several opportunities to embrace the joy and responsibility of responding boldly and generously to this call to be a house of the poor.

Jesus told us that the greatest commandment in the law is to love God and your neighbor as yourself. And so, will journey together this year to rediscover the joy of living this twofold commandment by becoming:

A House of Prayer and a House of the Poor.

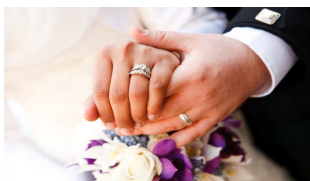
