WHAT IS EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL?

The U.S Bishops have recognized that many Catholics do not understand or believe in the gift that Jesus has given us in the Holy Eucharist. To change that they have created a three year movement, "The Eucharistic Revival". As Shepherds, from Pope Francis to the Bishops and our Priests this is for you a Catholic. These leaders would like healing, conversion, formation, and unification. For the life of our Church and the world. This Year of Parish Revival, which began on the Feast of Corpus Christi, includes three distinct invitations to offer opportunities to better understand this gift from Jesus Christ. The first invitation is to reinvigorate worship, The second is to encounter Jesus. The third is through robust formation.

What are we doing at St. Edward? We started with a novena for Corpus Christi. We had a Eucharistic Procession on the feast of Corpus Christi and included a day of crafts and games for kids honoring the reception of First Communion. Currently we are having adoration of the Holy Eucharist every Friday evening at 6:00 followed by sharing dinner in Knight Hall. We are having an in depth study from Bishop Baron on the Mass, including books from Bishop Baron and Matthew Kelly.

This third year of the Revival will be marked by historic initiatives that will propel our nation into a new chapter of faith and mission.

- Just as crowds followed Christ throughout his earthly ministry, our nation will process with our Eucharistic Lord from the north, south, east, and west edges of our country in the first-ever National Eucharistic Pilgrimage. Thousands will have a powerful opportunity for encounter and healing as Jesus comes to meet them on his way to the National Eucharistic Congress.
- The 10th National Eucharistic Congress will be a milestone within the Revival and a historic moment for the Church in the U.S. The reinstitution of this legacy will gather 80,000 Catholics in Indianapolis for a transformative experience that will bear fruit for generations to come.
- These pivotal moments will launch the United States into the Year of Mission, sending on-fire Catholics back out into the world to share Christ's love "for the life of the world." We will continue to spread the Revival movement throughout the Church's 2025 Jubilee Year and beyond.

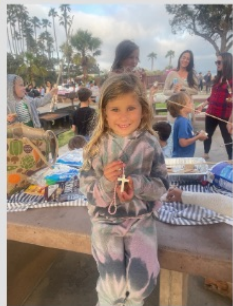

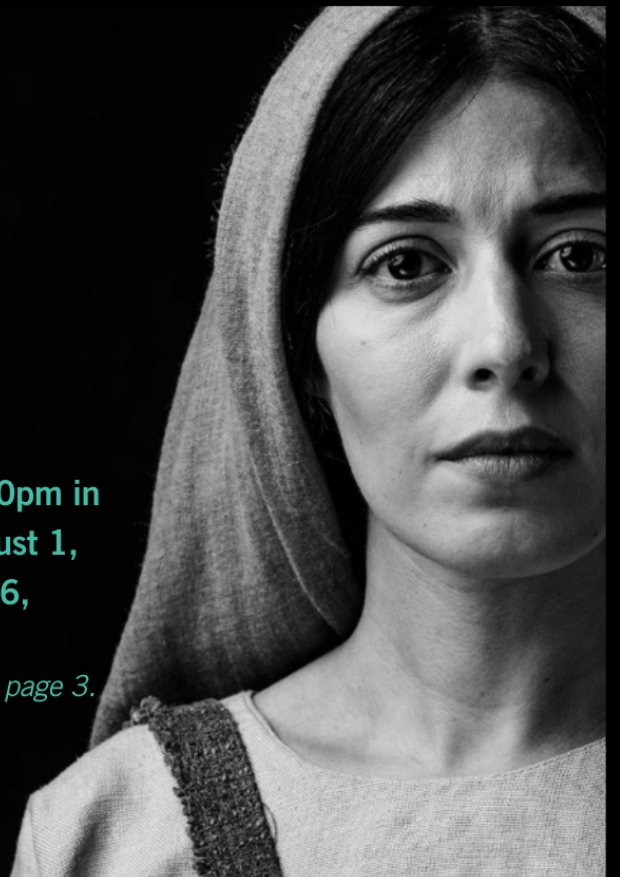
