Mary's Advent

This year, the Fourth Sunday of Advent presents to us St. Matthew's account of how the birth of Jesus came about: Mary was found with child through the Holy Spirit; this was communicated to Joseph by an angel; and so the Holy Family came to be.

We can learn a lot by meditating on Mary's Advent time, when she was carrying the Lord in her womb. We know from the Gospel of Luke that she went in haste to the home of her cousin Elizabeth. She went there to help Elizabeth, since the angel Gabriel had told her that her cousin was also expecting a child. The baby (John the Baptist) in Elizabeth's womb leaped for joy at the sound of Mary's voice, and Mary proclaimed her Magnificat, a joyful song of praise to the Lord.

That is how Mary's Advent was: a time of serving others, bringing joy (and bringing Christ himself) to others, and prayerfully singing the praise of God. What a beautiful example for us! During this final week before Christmas we also can serve and help those who need our help; we can joyfully bring Christ to others; and we can prayerfully sing the praise of God. In all these ways, we prepare ourselves for a more complete coming of Jesus' grace to our hearts and souls at Christmas time.

The Advent Season - Week 4

REV. JOSEPH SQUILLACIOTI, S.T.L.



Today on this last Sunday of Advent, we will consider the last two titles of the Christ – Emmanuel and King of nations (Emmanuel and Rex Gentium).

The Desire (King) of nations plays a special role as this verse as part of the prayer of the church comes right before Christmas which in a special way looks back in all of Salvation History to the creation of Adam and Eve (Roman Martyrology). He is truly the all-encompassing King of all people from the beginning. And in his coming as a child, we see that he must be nurtured just as we, too, must nurture our faith.

O King of all the nations, the only joy of every human heart; O Keystone of the mighty arch of man, come and save the creature you fashioned from the dust. From Isaiah: For a child is born to us, a son is given us; upon his shoulder dominion rests. They name him Wonder-Counselor, God-Hero, Father-Forever, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:5), and He shall judge between the nations, and impose terms on many peoples. They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks; one nation shall not raise the sword against another, nor shall they train for war again. (Isaiah 2:4).

And finally...Emmanuel! Literally God-with-us.

O Emmanuel, king and lawgiver, desire of the nations, Savior of all people, come and set us free, Lord our God. Already, Isaiah 7:14 had prophesied that the virgin would be with child and bear a son and shall name him Emmanuel. Pope Leo the Great wrote that in the new order there was a new nativity. He who was invisible in his own nature became visible in ours; he who is true God is also true man. In him, the humility of humanity and the loftiness of the godhead both meet.

The Advent-Christmas mystery is the mystery of the incarnation of the Son of God so that he may be one with us, sharing in our suffering and death so that we may share in the very life of God who cannot die.

There is an ancient song from the 7th century which is still sung by clergy during Advent around the world which sums up the spirit of the Advent season. It can be used as a prayer for us this last Sunday before the birth of our Savior...

Creator of the stars of night,

Thy people's everlasting light,

Jesu, Redeemer, save us all,

and hear Thy servants when they call.

Thou, grieving that the ancient curse should doom to death a universe, hast found the medicine, full of grace, to save and heal a ruined race.

Thou camest, the Bridegroom of the bride, as drew the world to evening tide, proceeding from a virgin shrine,

the spotless Victim all divine.

At whose dread Name, majestic now, all knees must bend, all hearts must bow; and things celestial Thee shall own, and things terrestrial Lord alone.

O Thou whose coming is with dread, to judge and

doom the quick and dead, preserve us, while we dwell below, from every insult of the foe.






