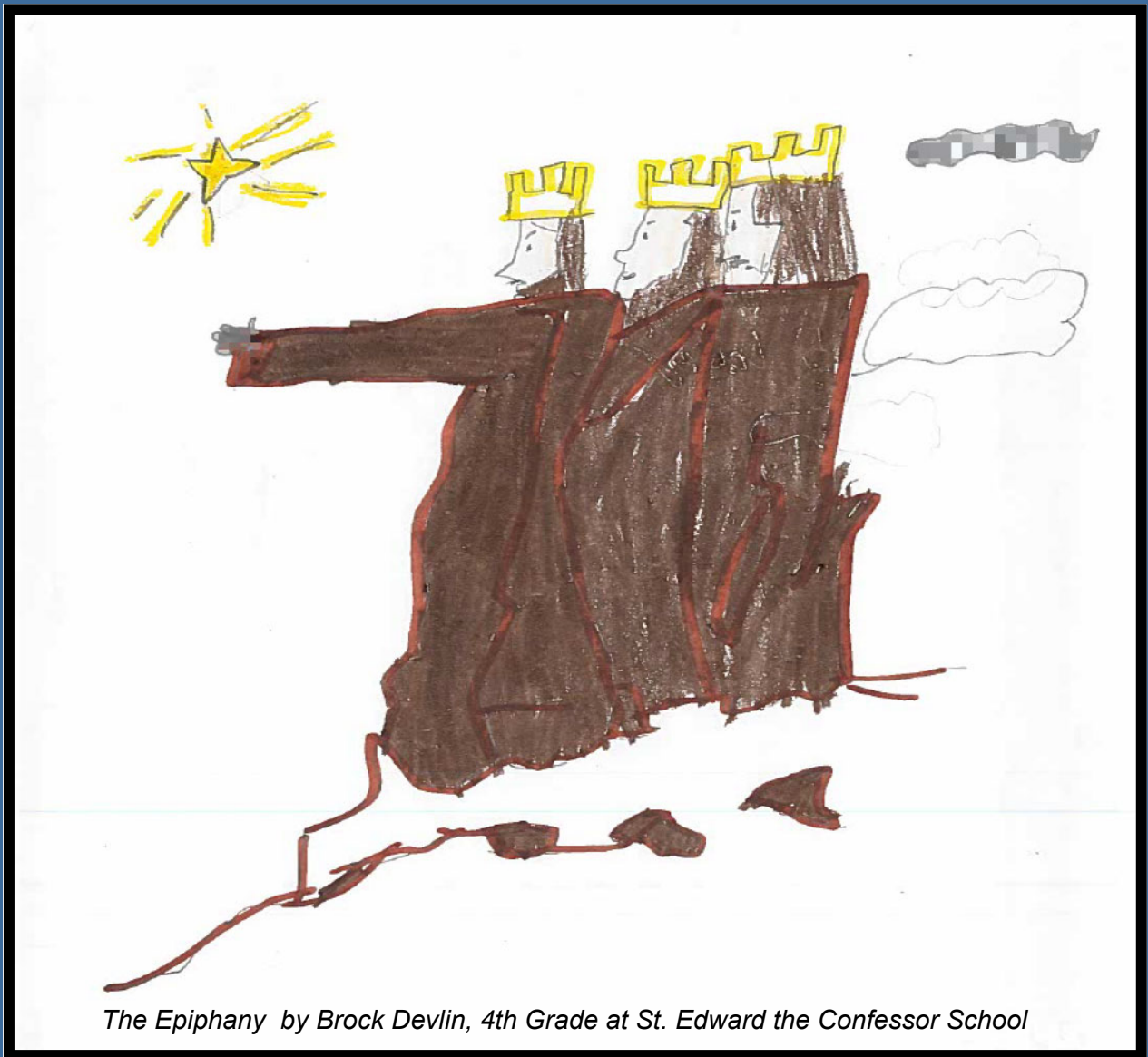

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

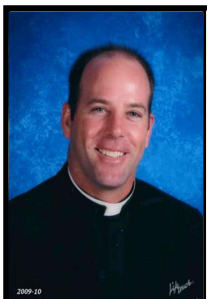

Jesus Pitches His Tent with Us

As we begin our Sundays of worship God in a tent, we are reminded of two important points of our faith. First, the season of Christmas shows how close God wishes to be to us. The Gospel of John tells us that "the Word became flesh and *pitched his tent* among us" (Jn 1:14). Jesus did not live somewhere "out there"; he lived – and lives – with us wherever we are. Jesus will always make his home with – and in us. Second, our temporary place of worship reminds us that we, the Church, are a pilgrim people. We are not to get too comfortable in our churches or homes. Instead, we are to live as if in tents, regularly pitching and pulling our tent, for "our citizenship is in heaven" (Phil 3:20). Let's keep moving together toward heaven knowing that wherever we've pitched our tent Jesus has pitched his tent with us.

A medida que empezamos nuestros domingos de alabanza a Dios en una casa de campaña, se nos recuerda de dos puntos importantes de nuestra fe. En primer lugar, la temporada de Navidad muestra lo cerca que Dios desea estar con nosotros. El Evangelio de Juan nos dice que "El verbo se hizo carne y puso su morada entre nosotros" (Juan 1,14). En lugar de ello, hemos de vivir como si estuviéramos en casas de campaña, lanzando regularmente y tirando de nuestra casa de campaña, porque "nuestra ciudadanía está en los cielos" (Filipenses 3:20). Sigamos juntos hacia el cielo sabiendo que donde quiera que hemos armado nuestra casa de campaña Jesús ha puesto la suya con nosotros.

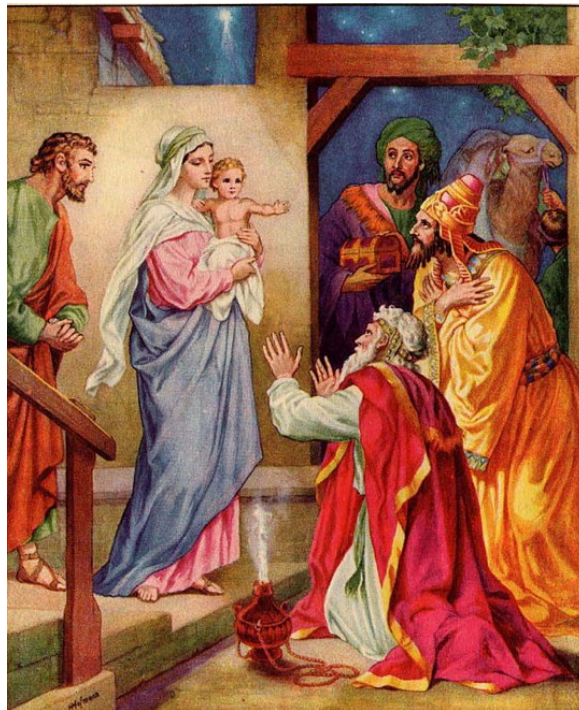

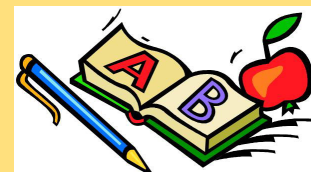

Misas dominicales, incluyendo el Sábado 5:30 pm Misa se llevará a cabo en una carpa climatizada situada junto al campo de la escuela. Con una capacidad de mil personas, la carpa tendrá un espacio cómodo para todos.

Misas diarias se celebraran en la Capilla de San Felipe de Jesús, ubicada en Capo Beach, a 1.5 millas de la Iglesia de San Eduardo el Confesor. La Misa diaria de 8:15 continuará como estaba previsto. La Misa de 5:30 pm se cambiará a las 5:00 pm de lunes a viernes, debido a las clases de educación religiosa que comienzan a las 6 pm.

Los bautismos y funerales tendrán lugar en La Capilla de San Felipe de Jesús. Debido a que la capilla tiene una capacidad de 175 personas, los funerales más grandes serán coordinados con las parroquias vecinas de acuerdo a la preferencia de la familia.

Confesiones continuarán los lunes a las 6:00 pm y los sábados de 4-5 pm en San Eduardo el Confesor, las confesiones serán en la Sala de Conferencias que está situada cerca de la entrada de la iglesia.

Please note the following changes which are effective December 29, 2014 - March 7, 2015

Sunday Masses, including the Saturday 5:30 pm, Mass will be held in a heated tent located next to St. Edward school field. With a seating capacity of one thousand, the tent will provide a comfortable space for everyone.

Daily Masses will be celebrated at our chapel, San Felipe de Jesus, located in Capo Beach, 1.5 miles from St. Edward the Confessor Church. The 8:15 am daily Mass will continue as scheduled. The 5:30 Mass will be changed to 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday due to religious education classes which begin at 6pm.

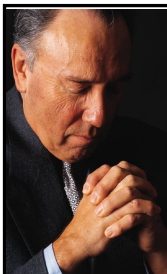
Baptisms and Funerals will take place at San Felipe de Jesus Chapel. Because the chapel has a capacity of 175 people, larger funerals will be coordinated with neighboring parishes according to the preference of the family.

You Are Invited to Participate in OneLife LA Walk for Life

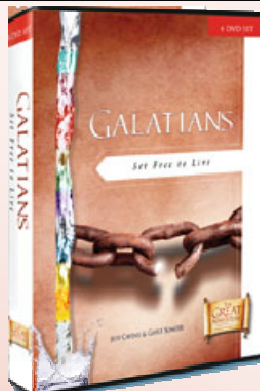
Saturday, January 17, 2015

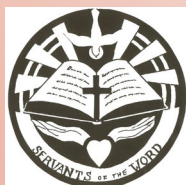

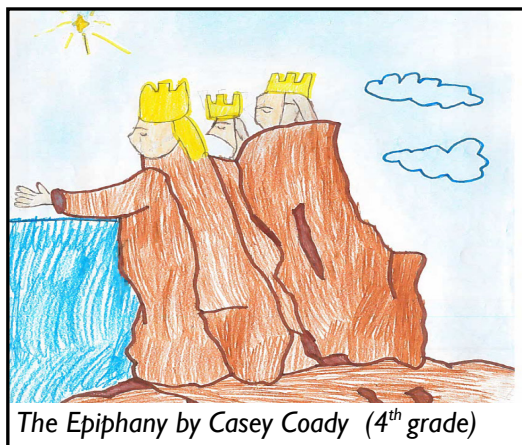
