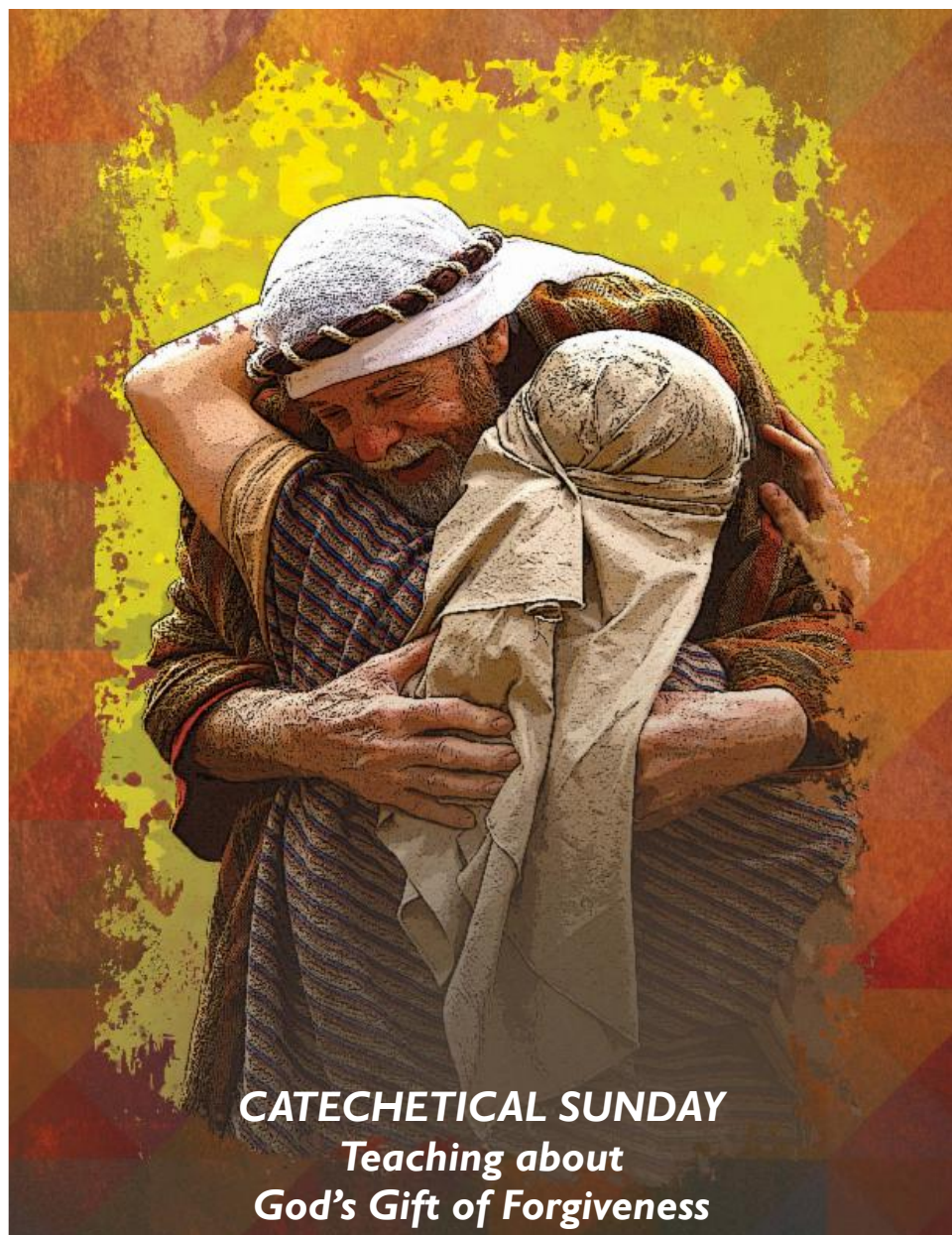

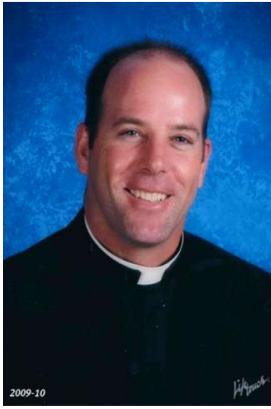

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

On the first and third Monday of each month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. The Diocesan intention for an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life.



Recent studies have shown that one of the most significant factors contributing to employee happiness is one's relationship with co-workers. Even employees who reported a negative relationship with their direct supervisor but a positive relationship with co-workers reported had a high level of overall happiness.

Perhaps today's gospel parable of the landowner hiring laborers to work in his vineyard was on St. Paul's mind when he wrote "we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building" (1 Cor 3:9). What an honor, joy and responsibility for each of us to be called by God to work with Him in fulfilling his mission of announcing the reign of God and transforming the world in the light of Christ.

All of the baptized are called to work toward the transformation of the world. Most do this by working in the secular realm...others do so on a limited and voluntary basis: for example, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, readers, choir members, catechists, pastoral council members, visitors to the sick and needy, and those who serve in programs such as sacramental preparation, youth ministry, including ministry with people with disabilities, and ministries of charity and justice. (Co-Workers in the Vineyard of the Lord, U.S.C.C.B., 2005)

How are you living out your call to be a "co-worker in God's service" in the secular world as well as in your parish? On this Catechetical Sunday, we thank and bless those of our parish who have responded to God's call to work with Him in the ministry of teaching.

Not only has God called us to work with him; he has also called us to work with one another. St. Paul called his fellow Christians "my co-workers in Christ Jesus" (Rom 16:3-16). I, too, call you my co-workers and rely on your help, no less than St. Paul did, in sharing in the work of serving God and others through the sharing of your time, talents and treasure. In God's house, there is work for both new and long-time parishioners as well as the young and the old.

In today's parable, the landowner found people standing around and asked them "Why do you stand here idle all day?" They answered, "Because no one has hired us." He said to them, "You too go into my vineyard." Consider yourself hired! Giving Hope

On October 13th, Fr. Brendan and 19 Saint Edward parishioners will be traveling to the slums of Jamaica and volunteer with the Missionaries of the Poor to give hope to the forgotten and those left on the streets to perish. We invite you to join us spiritually on our pilgrimage. We will take your special prayer intentions with us. The missionary brothers and your fellow parishioners will pray over them daily while at the monastery.

The brothers are in constant need of medical supplies, diapers and food. As an partial example of daily expenses; 600 lbs of Rice is \$180, four cases of Spam is \$312 and a case of medical gauze is \$45. The cost of 200 diapers a day is \$50.

The brothers feed and care for 400 people in their apostolic shelters and another 500 to 1000 on the streets everyday. It's understandable how supplies can be depleted rapidly and so costly to maintain. Therefore, we are appealing to you for a love donation that will aid us in obtaining these desperately needed items. Please help us if you can. There will be a second collection for your prayer intentions and/or donations at all the **Masses on October 4th & 5th**. Or you can leave them at the church office. Fr. Brendan will take your generous donation directly to the Missionaries of the Poor on this missionary trip.

BREAKING NEWS



Although St. Edward the Confessor Church was founded in 1950 in Capo Beach, the current church was dedicated on December 11, 1994.

The church has served us very well over these twenty years. Consider the fact that we currently celebrate over 900 Masses, 250 baptisms, 100 weddings, 400 First Communions, 300 Confirmations, and 70 funerals every year. In addition, the church sponsors concerts, hosts school events, classes and retreats throughout the year.

After twenty years of heavy use, it's time for us to reinvest in our beautiful church.

In 2012, our former pastor, Fr. Steve Sallot, hired a liturgical consultant and formed a committee of staff members and parishioners to discuss options for renovating the church.

Following the recommendation of our parish pastoral council and the finance council, I have asked Bishop Vann for permission to pursue the renovation of the church this winter.

If the bishop allows us to proceed a proposal will be prepared under the guidance of the diocesan Design and Renovation Committee and the Office of Construction Management.

We are in the beginning stages of the process and will keep you posted on the progress.



FINANCE COUNCIL CONSULTATIVE BODY TO PASTOR

Applications being accepted

Members of the Parish Finance Council will be chosen based on demonstrable skills or expertise in management and/or finance. We are specifically looking for someone in the legal and/or financial planning profession. If you are interested, or know of someone who would be a qualified candidate, please contact Fr. The Finance Council is a consultative body which works closely with the pastor, who is accountable to the diocesan bishop for the administration and stewardship of the temporal goods of the parish.

The pastor, according to Canon Law, has among his responsibilities, the responsibility for parish financial and temporal management. While the Parish Finance Council does not have decision making authority, consultation is at the heart of the decision-making process – sharing information, listening, contributing to the discussion, and promoting consensus.

MEMBERSHIP

The Parish Finance Council is about the life of a community of faith and, as such, its members should be members of that community of faith and should have a love for the Church and its mission and develop a thorough understanding of the parish's mission, goals, people and other resources. As in other matters, the Pastor may use his discretion in the selection of qualified members from the parish community.

TERMS

Each Finance Council member shall serve a three-year term, commencing on the first day of their appointment to the Finance Council by the Pastor. All members may be appointed to succeed themselves, but shall serve no more than two (2) full consecutive terms or six (6) years whichever comes first, and shall not then be eligible for reappointment until an interval of at least one (1) year.

MEETING PROTOCOLS

Meetings are currently scheduled 10 months a year on the last Monday of each month September-June. Since the purpose of the Parish Finance Council is to provide advice and support to the pastor, the pastor should be present at the Parish Finance Council meetings.

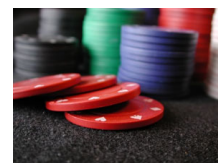

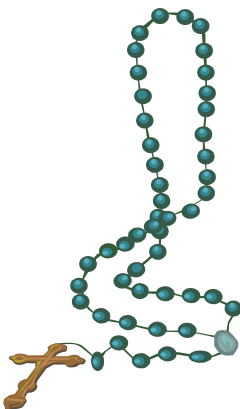
