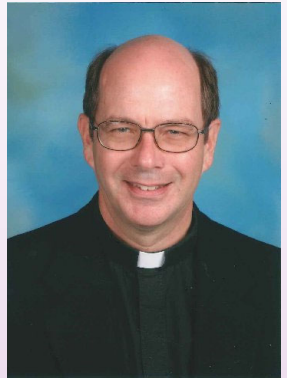

Advent

On December 1st we begin a new liturgical year in the Church. (This makes it a good day for a "New Year's resolution.") The season of Advent is our time to prepare spiritually for the great feast of Christmas. We often speak of the "spirit of Christmas," and it is good that we identify the true spirit of the feast. But we cannot really enjoy the spirit of Christmas if we do not first have the spirit of Advent. It is a time of preparation for Christ, longing for Christ, and identifying the parts of our own lives that are most in need of a greater presence of Christ. In a sense Advent represents life itself, since our entire earthly life is a preparation for eternal life with Christ.



There are numerous ways to make this a season of true preparation for the Lord. The booklets that are available in the back of our church beginning this weekend have a short reflection each day, inviting you "Into the Stillness" where we encounter the Lord most intimately. You might want to have an Advent wreath in your home, and light the appropriate candle(s) each evening during dinner. (I hope you eat dinner together as a family.) You might consider coming to morning or evening Mass on one or more days during the week. Contributions to charitable causes are particularly appropriate during this time, when the needs of the poor are most strongly felt.

Let's enter into the spirit of Advent as fully as possible, so the spirit of Christmas may find its home in us.

El 1 de diciembre comenzamos un nuevo año litúrgico en la Iglesia.
(Este es un buen día para una "resolución de Año Nuevo").

La temporada de Adviento es el momento de prepararnos espiritualmente para la gran fiesta de Navidad. A menudo hablamos del "espíritu de la Navidad", y es bueno que identifiquemos el verdadero espíritu de las fiestas. Pero realmente no podemos disfrutar el espíritu de la Navidad si primero no tenemos el espíritu de Adviento. Es un tiempo de preparación para Cristo, anhelo de Cristo e identificación de las partes de nuestras propias vidas que más necesitan una mayor presencia de Cristo. En cierto sentido, el Adviento representa la vida misma, ya que toda nuestra vida terrenal es una preparación para la vida eterna con Cristo.

Entremos en el espíritu de Adviento lo más plenamente posible, para que el espíritu de Navidad pueda encontrar su hogar en nuestros corazones.

MONARCH NEWS: LIVING OUT THE WORDS OF ST. FRANCIS

One of the strengths of our Monarch school community is the opportunity for students of all ages to meaningfully contribute to our local community. In addition to each grade sponsoring a monthly service project, we have our Lions & Lamb campus ministry program and our eighth graders have regular opportunities to donate their time to local non-profits. Some recent service program highlights include:

- * The eighth grade class regularly works in the food pantries and serves meals at Isaiah House, San Felipe Pantry and Mary's Kitchen. In addition, several students made bracelets that were recently sold at Casa Teresa's gala, bringing in more than \$1000 to this organization that provides a loving home to women in crisis.
- * Third grade sponsored the Feed the Hungry food drive for the school's November service project. All of our Monarchs brought in hundreds of bags filled with non-perishable food and supplies for Serra's Pantry.
- * In October, second grade coordinated the Jeans 4 Jesus drive to raise money for Family Assistance Ministries. Students and faculty paid \$5 to wear jeans on Wednesday during the month of October. Through this and other fundraising initiatives, the class raised more than \$1,100, allowing FAM to purchase the five beds they desperately needed!
- * Our campus ministry - Lions & Lambs - made Thanksgiving placemats and delivered them to residents at local senior center.

A novena is a nine day period of private or public prayer to obtain special graces, to implore special favors, or make special petitions. (Novena is derived from the Latin *novem*, meaning nine.) In our liturgical usage, the novena differs from an octave which has a more festive character, and either precedes or follows an important feast.

In our Church calendar we celebrate the Octave before Christmas, where the recitation of the “O” Antiphons during vespers help us prepare for the birth of our Savior. We also celebrate the Octaves of Christmas and Easter, which include the feast days themselves and the seven days that follow, to highlight the joy of these mysteries. In the Middle Ages, particularly in Spain and France, novenas of prayers were offered nine days before Christmas, signifying the 9 months our Lord spent in the womb of our blessed Mother. These special novenas helped the faithful prepare for the festive, yet solemn, celebration of the birth of our Lord.

The origin of the novena in our Church’s spiritual treasury is hard to pinpoint. In the New Testament at the Ascension scene, our Lord gives the apostles the Great Commission, and then tells them to return to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit. “After that they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet near Jerusalem— a mere Sabbath’s journey away. Together they devoted themselves to constant prayer” (Acts 1:12,14). Nine days later, the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles at Pentecost. Perhaps, this “nine-day period of prayer” of the apostles is the basis for the novena.

Novenas still hold a legitimate place in our Catholic spirituality. The *Enchiridion of Indulgences* notes, “A partial indulgence is granted to the faithful, who devoutly take part in the pious exercise of a public novena before the feast of Christmas or Pentecost or the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary” (#34). Here the Church is again emphasizing that the novena is a pious, spiritual exercise to bolster the faith of the individual, and that the individual should be truly devout, always remembering the goodness of the Lord who answers all of our prayers according to His divine will.
