Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

On the first and third Monday of each month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration in San Felipe the 1st Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Parish Plan: Setting our Course

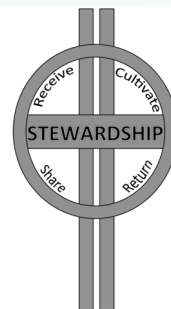
When Bishop Vann installed me as Pastor on July 12th, he talked about my patron saint, St. Brendan the Navigator, and about the role and responsibility of a pastor to navigate the parish like a ship on its Christian journey.

A ship docked in the harbor doesn't need a navigator; it isn't going anywhere. It is tied down and tucked safely away from the open and unpredictable water. St. Thomas of Aquinas said, "If the highest aim of a captain were to preserve his ship, he would keep it in port forever." I admit it's tempting. Like a beautiful ship, our parish could stay put and live in a calm, comfortable, predictable environment. I imagine that would make some people quite happy. But our church is a *pilgrim* church. It is a mission church built for the sea not for the harbor. Jesus tells us, "**Go out** to all the world and tell the good news."

So where are we going and what path are we going to take to get there? We are setting our parish compass to heaven. Everything that we do as a parish will be oriented to that singular goal, evangelizing and making disciples along our way. Over the course of this year, we will take three specific paths.

1. Stewardship: A Life of Joy and Gratitude

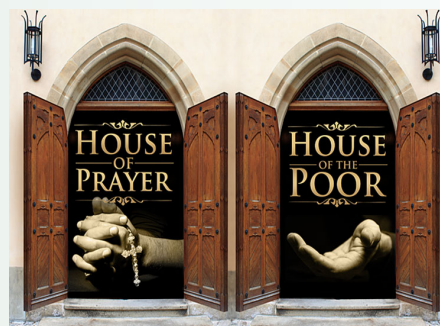
I want to increase your joy and gratitude this year. The Scriptures reveal that "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it." (Ps 24) God has entrusted it all to our care making us the stewards of His gifts. When we recognize everything we have and are as gifts from God, our lives are transformed with joy and gratitude, and we develop and share with others what God has shared with us. Throughout the year, we'll be reminded of the joy of Christian stewardship.



2. A House of Prayer and a House of the Poor

Jesus tells us that our entire Christian life depends on two inseparable commandments: love of God and love of our neighbor. Our parish compass will be set to living this twofold commandment. Prayer is the lifeblood of the Christian, a source of divine joy, and there is no limit to how deep we can go in prayer. It has been my experience that, in general, Catholics know a lot of prayers, but we aren't so good at just praying (extemporaneously). Over the course of the year, we will provide several opportunities to develop our prayer life as individuals, families, and a parish.

We also encounter the person and beauty of Christ in the least among us. Through baptism, God has made *us* His living dwelling place, a walking church and a House of the Poor where those in need can find the love of Christ and spiritual and material support. The parishioners of St. Edward the Confessor have long been known for their care of the poor. This year, we're going to do more, much more. Over the course of the year, there will be several opportunities for us to serve the poor and the marginalized hand-in-hand as individuals, families, and a parish.



3. Integration: One parish: church, chapel and school

Over the last several years, the parish has taken important steps to bring together parishioners who worship in English at St. Edward the Confessor Church and the Hispanic community which, until February 2014, worshiped exclusively at the parish chapel, San Felipe de Jesus in Capistrano Beach. Two years ago we also combined the parish preschool and elementary school, creating one unified parish school. This year, we will be more intentional in creating opportunities for the *entire* parish to come together to pray, serve, and enjoy each other's company as one large, richly -diverse parish family.



Plan Parroquial: Definiendo nuestro Curso

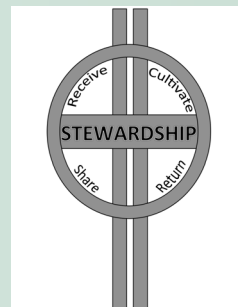
Cuando el obispo Vann me instaló como párroco el 12 de julio, habló de mi santo patrón, San Brendan el Navegante, y sobre el papel y la responsabilidad de un párroco al dirigir la parroquia como si fuera un barco en su camino Cristiano.

Un barco anclado en el puerto no necesita un capitán; este no va a ninguna parte. Está atado y escondido de forma segura lejos del mar abierto e impredecible. Santo Tomás de Aquino dijo: "Si el objetivo más alto de un capitán fuera preservar su barco, lo mantendría en el puerto por siempre." Admito que es tentador. Como un hermoso barco, nuestra parroquia podría quedarse y vivir en un ambiente tranquilo, cómodo y predecible. Me imagino que esto haría a muchas personas muy felices. Pero nuestra iglesia es una iglesia *peregrina*. Es una iglesia con una misión construida para navegar en mar abierto no para estar anclada en el puerto. Jesús nos dice: "Id por todo el mundo y proclamad el Evangelio."

Entonces, ¿hacia dónde vamos y qué camino vamos a tomar para llegar allí? Nuestra brújula parroquia nos guía al cielo. Todo lo que hacemos como parroquia estará orientado a ese objetivo singular, evangelizar y hacer discípulos a lo largo de nuestro camino. En el transcurso de este año, vamos a tomar tres caminos específicos.

1. Administración: Una vida de alegría y gratitud

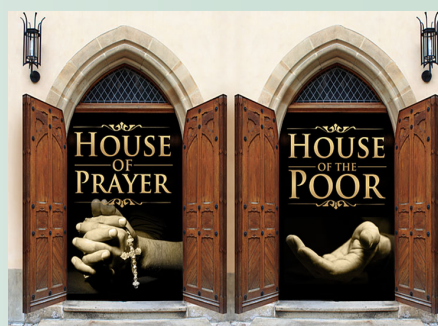
Quiero aumentar su alegría y gratitud este año. Las Escrituras revelan que "La tierra es del Señor, y todo lo que hay en ella, el mundo y los que en ella habitan." (Sal 24) Dios nos ha confiado todo a nuestro cuidado haciéndonos los mayordomos de sus dones. Cuando reconocemos que todo lo que tenemos y lo que somos es un regalo de Dios, nuestras vidas se transforman con alegría y gratitud, desarrollamos y compartimos con los demás lo que Dios nos ha dado. A lo largo del año, con alegría seremos recordados lo que es la buena administración Cristiana.



2. Una Casa de Oración y Casa de los Pobres

Jesús nos dice que toda nuestra vida cristiana depende de dos mandamientos inseparables: el amor a Dios y el amor al prójimo. Nuestra brújula parroquial se enfocará en vivir este doble mandamiento. La oración es el alma del cristiano, la fuente de la alegría divina, y no hay límite en cuanto a la profundidad que podemos ir en la oración. En mi experiencia, por lo general, los católicos se saben muchísimas oraciones, pero no son tan buenos rezando (extemporáneamente). En el transcurso del año, vamos a aprender a como desarrollar nuestra vida de oración individualmente, en familia y como parroquia.

También nos encontramos con la persona y la belleza de Cristo en el más pequeña entre nosotros. Por el bautismo, Dios nos ha hecho Su morada, una iglesia militante y una Casa de los Pobres, donde los necesitados puede encontrar el amor de Cristo y el apoyo espiritual y material que necesitan. Los feligreses de San Eduardo el Confesor durante mucho tiempo han sido conocidos por su cuidado a los pobres. Este año, vamos a hacer más, mucho más. En el transcurso del año, habrá varias oportunidades para nosotros de servir a los pobres y marginados mano a mano como individuos, en familia y como parroquia.



3. Integración: Una sola parroquia: iglesia, capilla y escuela

En los últimos años, la parroquia ha dado pasos importantes para reunir a los feligreses de San Eduardo el Confesor y a la comunidad hispana, que hasta en febrero del 2014, adoraban exclusivamente en la capilla de San Felipe de Jesús en Capistrano Beach. Hace dos años también combinamos el preescolar de la parroquia y la escuela primaria, la creación de una escuela parroquial unificada. Este año, nos enfocaremos más en crear oportunidades para que toda la parroquia junta se reúna a orar, a servir y disfrutar de la compañía de cada uno, como una gran familia parroquial y como una familia rica en diversidad.

If your love for Christ draws you to the Eucharist, please consider serving in this ministry. Extraordinary Ministers are a necessary part of our sacramental sharing of the Eucharist. With our new church layout we require more Extraordinary Ministers (EMs) to distribute Eucharist so more ministers are needed for all of our weekend Masses.

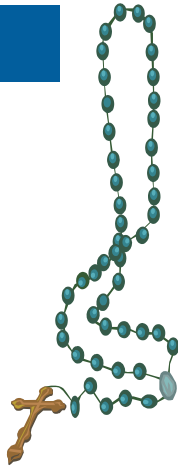

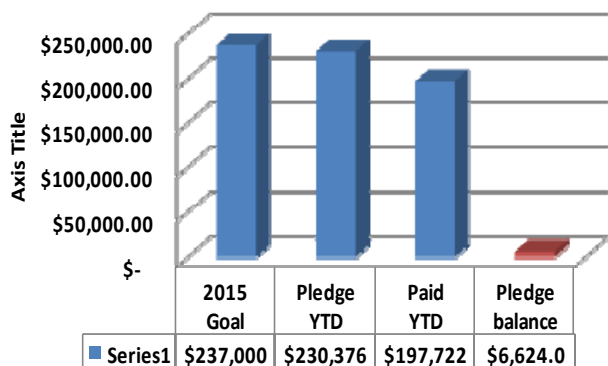
