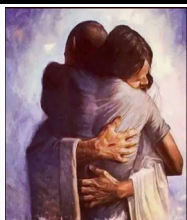

Turn to the Lord

The Scriptures tell us that there is a time for everything (Ecclesiastes 3:1). This includes a time to celebrate, as you see in this photo taken during the Monarch Main Event on February 22. We celebrated the great gift of Catholic Education and contributed to our Parish School, which provides an excellent Catholic Education to so many.

But now it is time to turn to the Lord with all our heart (Tobit 13:6), recognizing that the season of Lent invites us to deepen our relationship with the Lord and, with his help, to eliminate any obstacles to his Presence and work in us. How are you observing this holy season?



One good practice is praying the Stations of the Cross. We have Stations of the Cross at St. Edward the Confessor after our weekday morning Masses, and also after the Friday evening Mass. If you come to the Friday evening Stations, you can stay for a soup supper in Knight Hall. The soup suppers are sponsored by various ministries in the parish, and the proceeds from the suppers will go to our St. Vincent de Paul Ministry, which does wonderful service in helping the poor. In this way you can practice all three Lenten observances: prayer (because the Mass and Stations is wonderful prayer), fasting (because the soup supper, while delicious, is simple) and almsgiving (because the supper makes money for the poor).

I also recommend to you our wonderful book of Lenten meditations, "Into the Mystery." You will find thought-provoking Scripture-based reflections for each day of this season. If you like, you can supplement these reflections by listening to the weekly podcast recorded by our Faith Formation director, Donna Couch, and me.

However you choose to observe this holy time, let's all enter into the spirit of conversion, turning to the Lord with all our heart. That will lead to an Easter without regrets: a time when we will have good reason to celebrate in union with the Risen Christ.

Regresa al Señor

Las Escrituras nos dicen que hay un tiempo para todo (Eclesiastés 3:1). Esto incluye un tiempo para celebrar, como puede ver en esta foto tomada durante el Evento Principal de Monarcas el 22 de febrero. Celebramos el gran regalo de la Educación Católica y contribuimos a nuestra Escuela Parroquial, que brinda una excelente Educación Católica a muchos.

Pero ahora es el momento de recurrir al Señor con todo nuestro corazón (Tobías 13:6), reconociendo que la temporada de Cuaresma nos invita a profundizar nuestra relación con el Señor y, con su ayuda, a eliminar cualquier obstáculo y trabaja en nosotros mismos ¿Cómo estás observando esta temporada sagrada?

Una buena práctica es hacer las Estaciones de la Viacrucis. Haremos las Estaciones del Viacrucis en San Eduardo el Confesor después de las Misas de la tarde durante la semana, y también después de la Misa del viernes por la noche. Si vienes a las Estaciones del viernes por la noche, después puede quedarse a cenar en Knight Hall. Las cenas de sopa son patrocinadas por varios ministerios en la parroquia, y las ganancias de las cenas se destinarán a nuestro Ministerio de San Vicente de Paúl, que hace un maravilloso servicio para ayudar a los pobres. De esta manera puedes cumplir con las tres prácticas de la Cuaresma: oración (porque la Misa y las Estaciones es una oración maravillosa), ayuno (porque la cena de sopa, aunque deliciosa, es simple) y dar limosna (porque la cena hace dinero para los pobres).

También les recomiendo nuestro maravilloso libro de meditaciones cuaresmales, "En el Misterio". Encontrará reflexiones basadas en las Escrituras que invitan a la reflexión para cada día de esta temporada. Si lo desea, puede complementar estas reflexiones escuchando el podcast semanal grabado por nuestra directora de Formación de Fe, Donna Couch, y yo.

Independientemente de cómo elija observar este tiempo sagrado, entremos todos en el espíritu de conversión, volviéndonos al Señor con todo nuestro corazón. Eso conducirá a una Pascua sin remordimientos: un momento en que tendremos buenas razones para celebrar en unión con Cristo Resucitado.

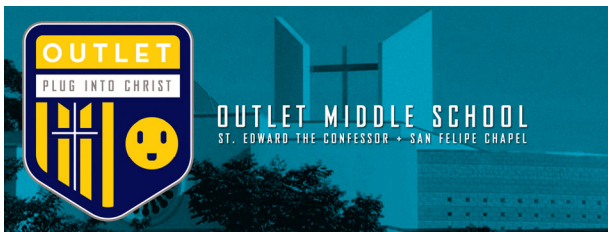

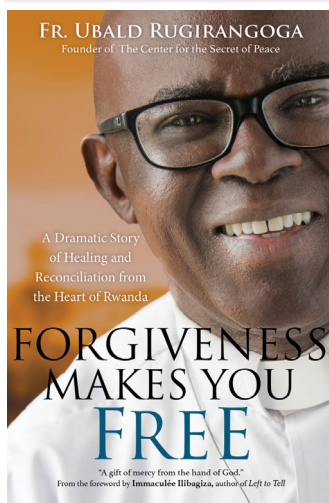

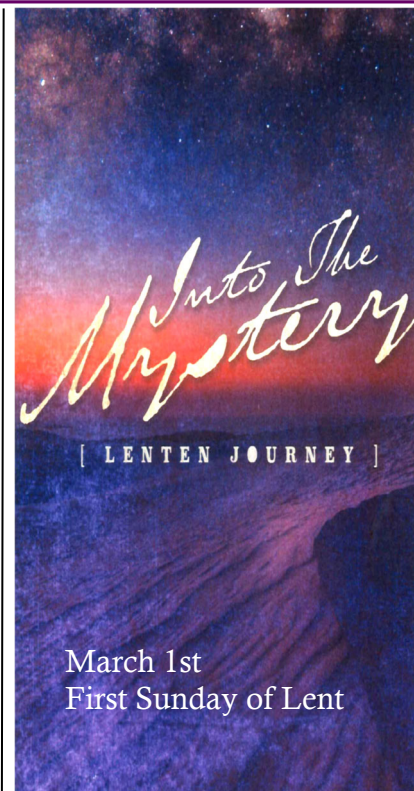
Topic: "Peace & Healing through Forgiveness"

Fr. Ubald Rugirangoga has been a Roman Catholic priest for 25 years in the Cyangugu Diocese of Southeastern Rwanda. During the 1994 genocide Fr. Ubald lost over 80 members of his family and over 45,000 of his parishioners were exterminated. He escaped through the Congo on foot in the middle of the night. When he left Rwanda he made a promise to his Bishop that he would return to bring healing to his

people. He spent 3 months in Belgium during the genocide and he said he cried every day. After a trip to Lourdes where he heard Jesus tell him "Ubald, carry your cross," he felt a release from the burden of his sorrows and knew he was called to preach healing, forgiveness and reconciliation. Fr. Ubald has a beautiful healing gift and his focus is on healing and evangelization wherever he goes.

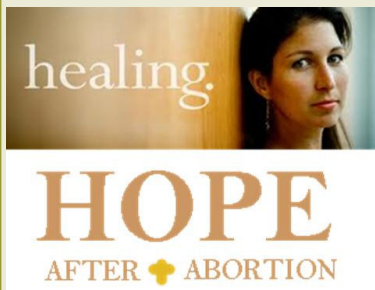

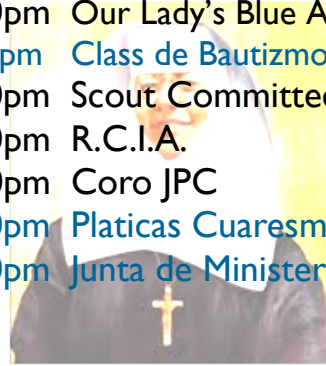

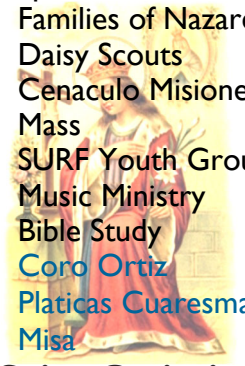

Twelve Reasons From The Teachings Of The Church For Wanting To Spend One Hour With Jesus In The Blessed Sacrament By Fr. John A. Hardon, S.J.

10. If Jesus were actually visible in church, everyone would run to welcome Him, but He remains hidden in the Sacred Host under the appearance of Bread, because He is calling us to faith, that we many come to Him in humility. "The Blessed Sacrament is the Living Heart of each of our churches and it is our very sweet duty to honor and adore the Blessed Host, which our eyes see, the Incarnate Word, Whom they cannot see." (Pope Paul VI, Credo of the People of God)

11. With transforming mercy, Jesus makes our heart one with His. "He proposes His own example to those who come to Him, that all may learn to be like Himself, gentle and humble of heart, and to seek not their own interest but those of God." (Pope Paul VI, Mysterium Fidei)

12. If the Pope himself would give you a special invitation to visit him in the Vatican, this honor would be nothing in comparison to the honor and dignity that Jesus Himself bestows upon you with the Invitation of spending one hour with Him in the Blessed Sacrament. "The Divine Eucharist bestows upon the Christian people the incomparable dignity." (Pope Paul VI, Mysterium Fidei)

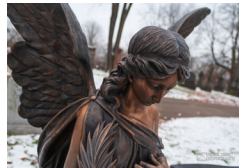

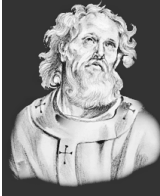
