Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

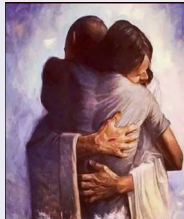

Liturgical Changes During Lent

During this penitential season, our liturgical environment is simplified to help us enter into a “desert” encounter and lead us to a more prayerful & penitential disposition. While it is not mandated by the Church, our parish incorporates praying the Apostles’ Creed in place of the Nicene Creed, and Greek (Kyrie) & Latin Mass parts (*Sanctus*, Memorial Acclamation, *Agnus Dei*) to clearly set apart the liturgical season of Lent.

Here are some additional changes you may have noticed.

- ❖ Church décor is simplified; only 2 altar candles; simple violet decorations
- ❖ Music has been toned down as well; no drums; no closing song (just simple instrumental)
- ❖ The Gloria is omitted during Lent except on Feasts and Solemnities
- ❖ “Alleluia” is not said/sung during Lent; “Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!” is used as the Gospel Acclamation
- ❖ Longer pauses before prayers and between scripture readings
- ❖ Chanted “The Word of the Lord,” “The Gospel of the Lord,” and the Our Father

Our Future.

In this picture you see me wearing alb and purple stole, ready to hear Confessions during a retreat for our Confirmation students last week. The retreat was at the Lazy W Ranch (hence the rustic background), and I was glad not only to provide the Sacrament of Reconciliation, but also to bring the Eucharist with me so that the students could experience Eucharistic Adoration. In particular, I was glad to show my support to our young people and to the exceptional youth ministry our parish provides.



Our young people really do represent our future. They will be around to carry on long after we older folks have passed away. We owe it to them, and we owe it to our Church and our world, to prepare them for the future as well as possible. In our parish youth ministry, this means faith formation, participation in the life of the parish community (most especially through participation in the sacraments), and experiences like last week's retreat. There are many voices and values in the world that compete with our Catholic faith and Catholic values; through dynamic and effective youth ministry, we hope to equip our young people to discern God's will and to follow God's way.

Please pray for our youth ministry and all who participate in it.
