### Rejoice

The Third Sunday of Advent has a nickname: "Gaudete Sunday." Gaudete is first word of the Entrance Antiphon for this day in Latin, and it means "Rejoice!" The full text of the antiphon is "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed the Lord is near." (Phil. 4:4-5) Joy is a special theme for this day. There are many reasons to rejoice in the Lord, especially in our parish.

We rejoice that we have a beautiful Pastoral Center and Knight Hall. Indeed, all of the rooms have been in constant use since the building was opened. It is great to have school events, faith formation and youth events, Bible studies, lectio divina, and other spiritually enriching, community building activities. Along with these are meetings for various ministries, parish staff, and administration. We are putting our beautiful building to good use!

Another special reason for joy is actually a large group of reasons. 

## The Advent Season - Week 3

### REV. JOSEPH SQUILLACIOTI, S.T.L.



Gaudete Sunday, the third Sunday in Advent gets its name from the traditional Latin entrance hymn whose first word is "Gaudete!" or Rejoice! This ancient hymn gives us the entire mood of the Mass: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Let your forbearance be known to all, for the Lord is near at hand; have no anxiety about anything, but in all things, by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God. Lord, you have blessed your land; you have turned away the captivity of Jacob."

The color rose is used to signify the joy we have in rejoicing. Gaudete Sunday provides us with a break about midway through Advent – a season which otherwise is more penitential in character and conversion oriented. It signifies the Lord's coming.

### O come thou Dayspring from on high..

Traditionally, we sing this verse directed to the Dayspring or Morning Star (*Oriens*) on December 21st, the shortest day of the year. As the Light of the World comes, the days get longer and the darkness is dispelled. In asking the Morning Star to dawn upon us, to scatter the darkness of sin and death and allow the Sun of Justice to shed his rays upon us, we are doing more than praying for a certain event to take place.


We are asking to be transformed by the coming of Christ (the Sun of Justice), that we ourselves may live as children of light.

O Radiant Dawn, splendor of eternal light, sun of justice: come, shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death.

From a prophecy by Isaiah: the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shown. (Isaiah 9:1).

Not only does Isaiah talk about light in his prophecies, but also in the book of Wisdom. Recall also that our reflection on the verse about wisdom describes the Messiah as the Wisdom of the Father.

The Advent mystery makes real what one reads in Wisdom 7:26, that Wisdom is a reflection of eternal light, the spotless mirror of the power of God, the image of his goodness. Light allows us to see and illuminate what is before us just as Jesus allows us to see God in the flesh.

# Pastoral Center Blessing & Open House
















